Thousands of persons have assured us of their support and we now rely on them to fulfill their pledges; we are ready to do our part; no delay will be due to our inaction.

As soon as the Commission has its work under way regular reports of progress will be made in these columns.

Finally, let the \$20.00 from each Branch and the voluntary contribution from each sympathizer come in at once, as we are in earnest and mean to push this work with all the energy at our command.
