TORONTO, Ont., June 28— The National Executive Committee of the Labor Progressive (Communist) party said today that Mr. Khrushchev owed the world's "Socialists" a fuller explanation how Stalin's one-man rule was permitted to happen.

The statement called on the Soviet Communist party to "explain what incorrect theories and concepts, or failures on the part of other members of the Central Committee, led to Stalin's arrogation of such extraordinary powers and to the establishment of a cult."
