MISS FLYNN A CANDIDATE

Communist Will Run for City Council in 24th District

Miss Elizabeth Gurley Flynn, a long-time Communist, will be an independent candidate for the City Council in Manhattan. She will run in the Twenty-fourth District, which extends from the Battery up the East Side to Forty-first Street.

Miss Flynn's candidacy was announced yesterday by Miss Evelyn Wiener and Dr. Albert E. Blumberg. She will run, it was said, as the candidate of the People's Rights party. To get her name on the ballot, the committee must obtain the signatures of 3,000 voters on independent nominating petitions by Sept. 23.

In past elections, Miss Flynn has often run unsuccessfully under the Communist banner. She recently completed a three-year prison sentence following her conviction for violating the Smith Act, which deals with subversive activities.
