DAILY WORKER HERE HEADLINES SHAKE-UP

The Daily Worker, Communist party newspaper here, announced the changes in the Soviet Communist party Presidium in today's edition with a five-column headline on its front page. The headline read: "Four Leaders Ousted from Soviet Communist Party Central Committee."

The dispatch, from London, was attributed to the Moscow radio.

The report mentioned the ouster of Vyacheslav M. Molotov, Georgi M. Malenkov, Lazar M. Kaganovich and Dmitri T. Shepilov. There was no mention that Mikhail G. Pervukhin had been demoted and Maxim Z. Saburv had been dropped from the party Presidium.

The London dispatch was followed by a much longer United Press dispatch from Moscow, which dealt with Pravda's demand for complete unity among

all members of the party.

The Daily Worker carried no editorial or other analysis of the Soviet shake-up.
