In Flint, Michigan, the bourgeoisie is intensifying its attacks on the standard of living of the working class. These recent strikes (truckers at Hamady Brothers Food Markets, truckers at Buick, and Chevrolet Truck and workers at Hall Steel) bear witness to this. Coupled with these have been fascist attacks particularly against the Negro national minorities. In recent months we have witnessed a sham integration plan by the Flint Board of Education. Seventeen year old Ken Nard is now serving a double life sentence for a crime he could not have committed.

Recently, the most vicious attacks have come from city government; namely, from Prosecutor Leonard, Police Chief Szaba, and Mayor Rutherford himself. The recent case of Madeline Fletcher, who was accused of assault with intent to do great bodily harm has opened a Pandora's box to Flint's own Watergate! Miss Fletcher was acquitted by a working class jury. However, despite the fact that she was found not guilty; despite the fact that the Prosecutor, Police Chief and the Mayor admitted in testimony at the trial that "racism" and "sexism" existed in the police department; justice has not been done!! has refused to press charges against Ms. Fletcher's assaillant, Kalberer, who shot her in the incident. A number of organizations have and are waging militant struggles against this and other gross injustices against the working class of Flint. A public hearing will soon be scheduled to allow the entire community and other mass organizations to voice their outrage.

The workers in Flint realize that the Democrats and Republicans cannot and will not bring to them jobs, peace and equality. None of the present candidates have taken a stand on these issues. The Communist Labor Party has entered these struggles in a real way and the workers of Flint are realizing that they need a voice in the state legislature this year!
