Morris Hillquit of New York City and Victor L. Berger of Milwaukee, Wisc., were the only two candidates for the National Executive Committee chosen on the first ballot. Both have served the party for years as Executive Committeemen, although neither is a member of the present committee. Hillquit received 17,336 votes, while 17,070 were given to Berger. The three vacancies will be filled by taking a second ballot, the results of which it is hoped will be in by June 1 [1916]. The names of those who will appear on the second ballot and the vote they received on the first ballot are as follows: Anna A. Maley, 10,508; John Spargo, 10,175; Arthur LeSueur, 8,275; John M. Work, 7,825; H.G. Creel, 7,660, and A.M. Simons, 6,531. The vote for all the candidates...is as follows:
