The Military Revolutionary Committee of the Petrograd Council of Workers' and Soldiers' Deputies gives her the right of free travel through the entire Northern Front with the purpose of reporting to our American comrades, internationalists, about the events in Russia. Signed by the Secretary and Chairman.

AFTER HE BECAME MINISTER OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS.

This is a permit for free travel for the entire Russian Front and not only the Northern Front. Dated Oct. 16, 1917.






