"The More I Think of the Outcome": Excerpt from a Letter to G.A. Hoehn (July 9, 1898)

The more I think of the outcome at Chicago, the more I am convinced that the wisest counsels prevailed. I am going to try and get in shape for the greater work ahead, the very though of which arouses all my energy and ambition. I am full of faith in the future. The new party will blaze the way to victory. The noble people we met at Chicago linger with me still.
