

Haywood Talks On Radio Sunday On Negro Rights

CHICAGO, Ill., Oct. 23.—Harry Haywood, Communist candidate for Congress in the First Congressional District of Illinois, will broadcast a message to Negro workers over Station WENR, Chicago, Sunday evening at 6 p. m.

Haywood will discuss the Communist platform as it affects Negro workers and Negro people generally. Haywood's congressional platform declares in favor of the death penalty for lynchers, enforcement of the 13th, 14th and 15th amendments for people as well as property.

"The fourteenth amendment has been perverted into a weapon to defend monopoly corporations against the people. It was originally passed to protect the Negro people from the white overlords of the South. I intend to return it to its original purpose and put teeth into it," Haywood declared recently.

In his radio speech he will deal with the housing, job and social discrimination against Negroes, and how to cure them by working class political and economic organization.
