Slowly but surely it made headway, conquered one posi-tion after another, until at last with-in the past year it had grown strong enough to proceed to the publication of a central organ in the English language.

The DAILY WORKER is now al-most one year old, and it has bravely held its ground. In all the battles of American proletariat it has been a fearless leader. The attorney for the party, of course, would not permit the state to dispose of the case without touch-ing the real issue of using the law to keep the ticket of a workers' revolu-tionary party off the ballot. On his tionary party off the ballot. On his motion an adjournment was granted until Monday afternoon to prove the facts denied by the state.
