

## **FREIHEIT CRITICIZES USSR ON JEWISH CULTURE**

The Morning Freiheit, Yiddish language daily yesterday published an editorial on its English page criticizing the failure of the Soviet government to resume the development of Yiddish culture which once flourished in the Soviet Union.

The editorial declares that various promises and statements made to its correspondent who recently visited the Soviet Union about the re-establishment of a Yiddish theater and Yiddish publications have not been carried out.

The Freiheit editors say, "the time for glossing over things has passed." Their editorial adds:

"There is one lesson to be derived from the revelations made at the 20th congress of the CPSU, and that is that whenever there is something subject to serious criticism, such criticism must be voiced. Only in that way, only with the help of constructive criticism coming from people who are struggling and who will never cease to struggle for American-Soviet friendship in order to secure the peace, can mistakes be corrected—as they must be if the resumption of the sound Soviet practice that prevailed between 1917 and 1936 is really to be given serious consideration."
