SOVIET CP MAGAZINE HITS EDITORIAL ON HUNGARY

KOMMUNIST", theoretical journal of the Central Committee of the Communist Party of the Soviet Union, has expressed its disagreement with the Daily Worker on the Hungarian situation, according to Moscow new dispatches.

"Kommunist" said the Daily Worker had made an error in putting the events in Hungary and Egypt on the same plane. It accused the Daily Worker editorial of "babbling about the right of selfdetermination" and of failing to see the difference between Egypt-"invaded by imperialist interventionists"-and Hungary where "Soviet troops came at the call of the workers' and peasant's government to help Socialist patriotic forces".

"Kommunist" asserted that the position taken by the editorial writer "does not testify to the firmness of his principles or his under-standing of the processes under way in the world." It expressed the hope that when emotions receded the Daily Worker would take back its "hasty and unjust accusation" with regard to Soviet activi-

ties in Hungary.
