INTRODUCTION

Marxism-Leninism is the science of the working class. In its simplest form, Marxism-Leninism proves that the profit system does not work. It shows that capitalism only benefits a small handful. Marxism-Leninism systematically summarizes the historical experiences of the working class. It demonstrates that the workers cannot live in peace with the bosses. This has been proven by countless battles of workers which have consistently led to revolution since the Paris Commune in the 1860s.

Bosses try to hide, distort, and attack Marxist ideas. Marxist-Leninist ideas are not all that complicated. They are within the grasp of anyone who must fight the boss in order to get ahead. This pamphlet, of the Progress Labor Party, attempts to show a few of the basic ideas of Marxism-Leninism. It indicates the source of profits, the class struggle, the need for a communist party, and the necessity of armed struggle in order to seize power from the ruling class, etc.

This pamphlet, in cartoon form, should be used as a discussion guide to Marxist education. Naturally, there are many other important concepts to learn. And, Marxism-Leninism is more complex than shown in these cartoons. However, these drawings are a good place to begin—for without the ideas and practice of Marxism-Leninism workers

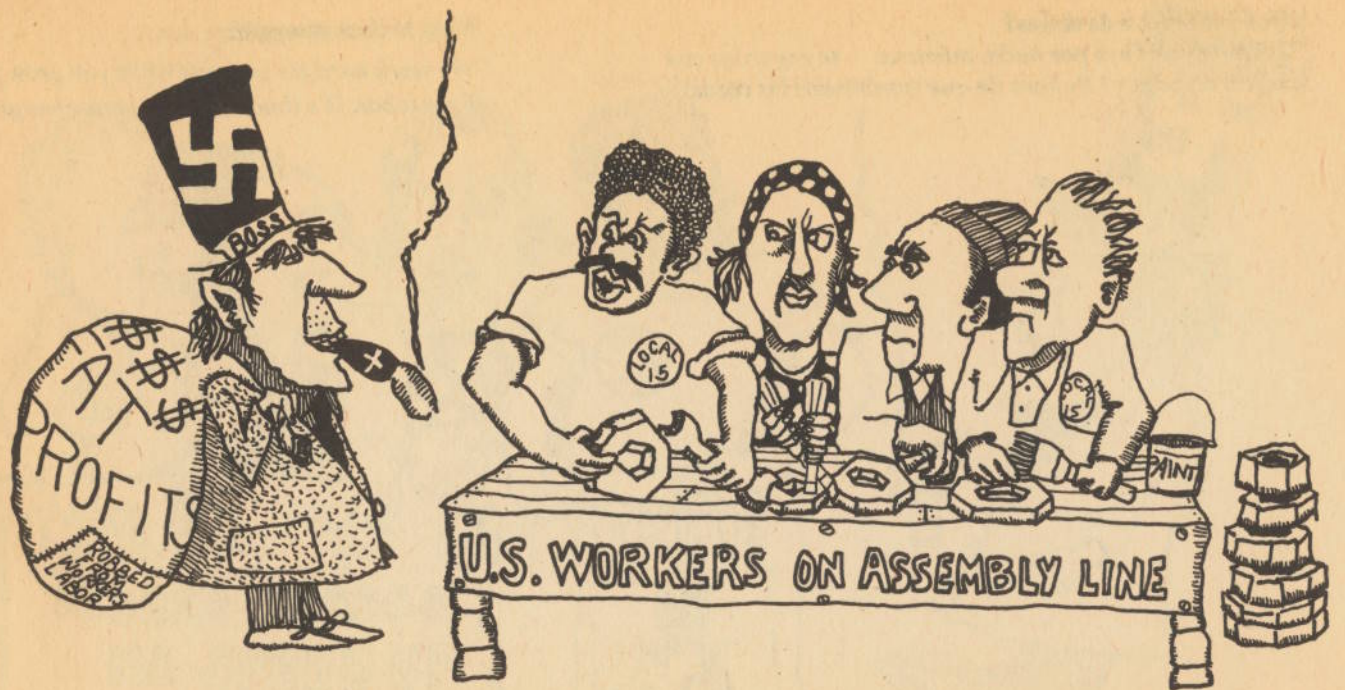
can never hope to free themselves from bosses' oppression. We know from history—not so distant history—that millions of workers around the world have utilized these ideas to march ahead. INTRODUCCION

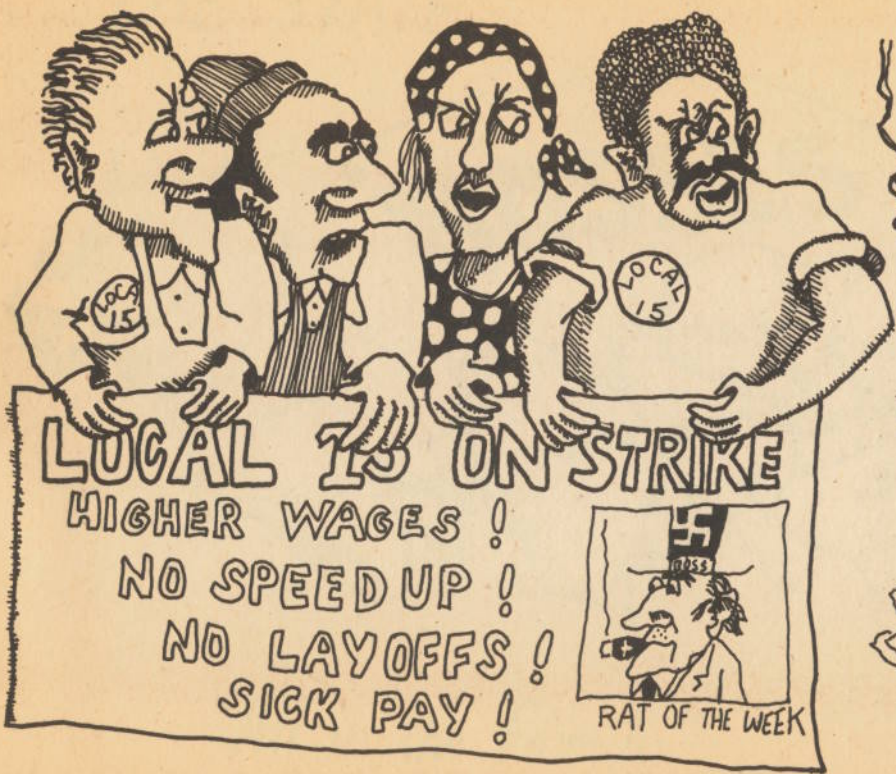
El marxismo-leninismo es la ciencia de la clase obrera. En su forma más simple, el marxismo-leninismo prueba que el sistema capitalista no funciona. Muestra que el capitalismo sólo beneficia a un grupo reducido de personas. El marxismo-leninismo resume sistemáticamente las experiencias históricas de la clase trabajadora. Muestra que los trabajadores no pueden vivir en paz con los patronos. Esto ha sido comprobado por innumerables batallas obreras que consistentemente, desde la Comuna de París del 1861 han conducido a revoluciones.

Los patronos tratan de esconder, tergiversar, y atacar a las ideas marxistas. Esas ideas no son tan complicadas. Se hallan al alcance de cualquiera que debe combatir al patrono para avanzar. Este folleto del Partido Laboral Progresista intenta mostrar unas pocas de esas ideas básicas del marxismo-leninismo. Indica las fuentes de ganancias, la lucha de clases, la necesidad de un partido comunista, y la necesidad de la lucha armada para tomar el poder y arrebatárselo a la burguesía, etc.

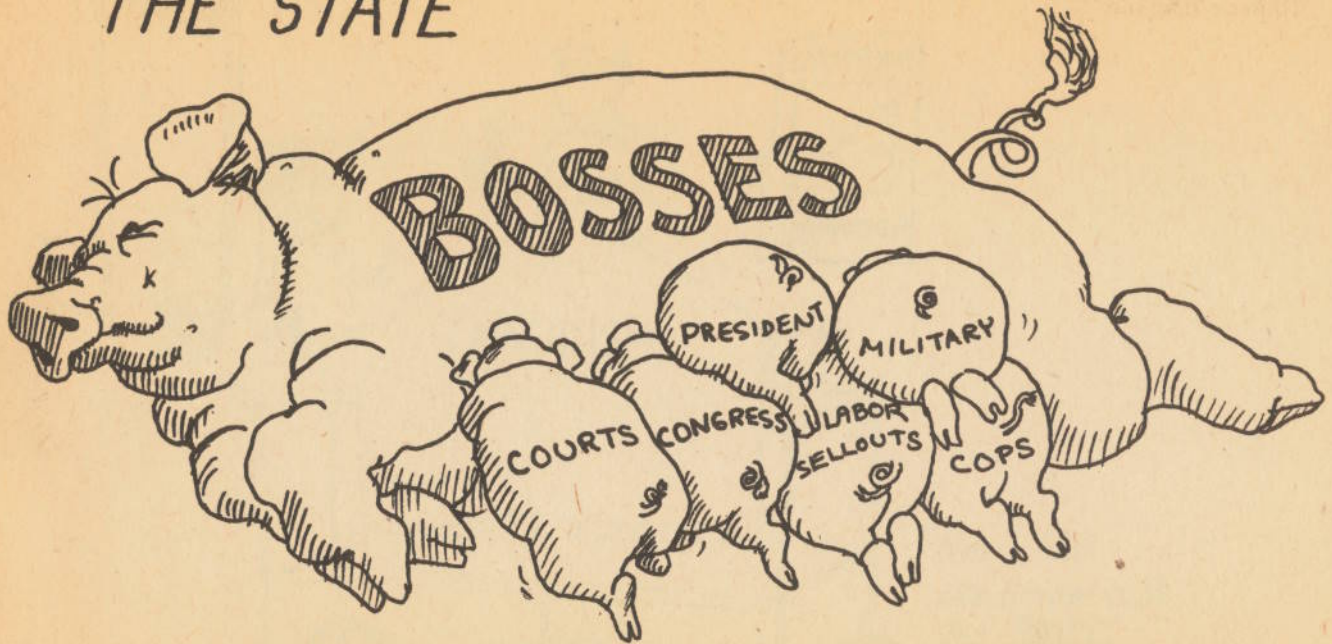

GOVERNMENT TO IMPORT SCABS
GROTON, Conn.—The Ford Administration, through its federal "mediator" Usury, has come out four-square on the side of General Dynamics for open strike-breaking of the 5-month-old walkout of 10,000 Electric Boat (E.B.) shipyard workers.

Usury told the press that the company should appeal directly to the rank-and-file to return to work on the basis of its latest (and "final") offer, through a letter to the home of every rank and file. If this doesn't work, then GD should bring in strike-breakers.

In preparation for these moves, the U.S. Navy has transported scabs from the submarine base here, stealing the jobs of minority and women.



PORTUGUESE CONSTRUCTION WORKERS

LISBON—More than 50,000 construction workers on strike for higher wages surrounded the Presidential Palace for several days and did not let Prime Minister Azevedo out until he agreed to give them 40 per cent wage increase. The workers, joined by steel, auto and farmworkers, won their demand, breaking the wage freeze which Azevedo's government tried to impose on the working class here.

IMPERIALISTS GET-TOGETHER

PARIS, Nov. 18—Ford, Valey Giscard, Takeo Miki, Harold Wilson, Aido Moro and Helmut Schmidt concluded their summit meeting here "promising" cooperation to put an end to the crisis suffered by the international capitalist system. Nothing was solved at this meeting. The working class of these countries, 12 million of which are unemployed, should expect just more of the same out of this meeting of butchers.
