We must regretfully announce that we are suspending the publication of OBREROS EN MARCHA for an indeterminate period of time.

In mid-January, a split occurred in MINP-El Comite. This situation, of course, has affected the work of our organization in all its areas.

At present, we are involved in analyzing the split, the political issues involved, and the process that led up to it. This includes looking at the organization from all angles: our goals and projections, our achievements and failures, our strengths and weaknesses. This evaluation is crucial in order for us to learn from this experience, consolidate the organization based on our understanding, and move ahead.

Although we are engaged in this analysis, we continue to be involved in mass work and in international solidarity efforts, particularly with respect to El Salvador. Nevertheless, we have had to take stock of our areas of work and prioritize our commitments.

We therefore will not be producing OBREROS EN MARCHA until such time that we can insure its production and publication on a regular basis. We are hopeful that this will become possible in the not-too-distant future.

We thank you for your support and we will keep you appraised of our developing situation. When OBREROS EN MARCHA resumes publication, your subscription will continue from that point on.
