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CL'S LINE DOES NOT ADHERE TO THE SCIENCE OF MARXISM-LENINISM AND CONCILIATES WITH MODERN REVISIONISM.

We consider it our obligation to identify for honest Marxist-Leninists on the local Continuations Committee those points where CL's line conflicts with Marxist-Leninists Unite and which therefore prevent the Continuations Committee from authorizing the presentation of this line at the fax Public Forum on Social Imperialism. Running through CL's position are two two basic trux tenets of every form of revisionism: (1) economism, as manifested in xammaxium CL's position that a socialist economy can exist under the domination of bourgeois politics, and (2) nexexherementers near the EMEMX attacking the conscious element, as: manifested in xhm CL's position that there can be socialism in the USSR without the uxininganuaxannimdim leadership of a Vanguard party of the proletariat guided by the ideology of m Marxism-Leninism.

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THE STATE. CL denies the fundamental reproposition of Marxism-Leninism that "the state is an organ of class rule, an organ for the oppression of one class by another" (State and Revolution). Instead CL says:

"The objective part of the superstructure is which consciously developed by the victorious class after battle; that fundamentally is the State. The State is represented by a constitution and the necessary laws to define that constitution, and the military and police apparatus, the prisons, etc. which enforce those laws. Thus the conscious element is constructed to safeguard and develop the productive relations which are the basis of the specific society."

What is ignored here is the main function of the state: (1) to suppress the capitalist class; (2) to suppress the capital relationship. It is because CL slurs over the repressive role of the A state under socialism that it can say that the bourgeoisie can seize the State apparatus but the that the socialist economic base will remain intact.

This proposition is revisionist and fundamentally Ex contradicts the ABC of Marxism -- that politics has prependent priority over economics.

2. THE PARTY. CL rejects the fundamental proposition of marxism-Leninism that socialism must be snymx x organized by the conscious struggle of the proletariat led by x its vanguard party. CL's position is that a bourgeois clique has seized unxamphamphame leadership of the CPSU but that the socialist economic base remains. This is equivalent to saying that there can be socialism wxx without a party of the proletariat. In fact in its article in the People's Tribune CL ignores the role of the Rxx Soviet Party in its account of Class Struggle in the Maxx USSR and mentions the party only once:

"Such a heroic people, such a glorious party will not be thrown back into the epoch of capitalist barbarism."

This The Chinesexed and Albanian comrades however tell us that it already has been. CL's position — that the ideology of a party and its leadership can be revisionist, but the party remain a proletarian party — is completely unscientific and has nothing to do with Marxism-Leninism.

3. THE SOCIALIST ECONOMIC BASE. CL says:

"the dictatorship of the proletariat leaps into existence without any base whatsoever."

This is identified metaphysical idealism, not dialectical materialism. The base for the dictatorship of the proletariat is large scale socialized production and the class which socialized production brings into being and tempers for the struggle for socialism. According to CL the function of the dimension dictatorship of the proletariat is to bring into being that socialist economic base rather than to suppress the capitalist relationship and to transform the process of production in a socialist way by perfecting socialist relations of production. The px purpose here is to weaken the instruments of the proletariat's dictatorship over capital. CL says:

So we can see that no anti-socialist ideas can arise out of the dictatorship

in the early wint stages, there is no base for these ideas to arise from. On the contrary, the reactionary forms of political activity are all hangovers of capitalism and do not arise on the basis of socialist relations. In fact, the morethe socialist relations are formed, the morethe state -- the objective aspect of the superstructure tends to wither."

The struggle against Lin Piao/has decisively repudiated xaxismminimix revisionism of this ax sort designed to weaken the dictatorship of the proletariat. Compare the statement by Mass Chairman Mao:

Socialist society covers a considerably long historical period. In the historical period of socialism, there are still classes, class contradictions and class struggle, there is struggle between the socialist road and the capitalist road, andthere is the many danger of capitalist restoration. Our instruments of dictatorship must be strengthened not weakened.

The struggle against modern revisionism is based on this lesson.

4. BUREAUCRACY. CL says that there can be no socialism without bureaucracy. This again is compeletely contrary to Lenin's teachings in State and Revolution:

Socialists demand the strictest control by society mx and by the state of the measure of labor and the measure of consumption; but this control must measure with the expropriation of the capitalist, with the establishment of workers' control over the capitalists, and must be exercised not by a minument of state of bureaucrats, but by a minument state of armed workers.

And also:

proletarian democracy . . . will take immediate steps to cut bureaucracy down to the roots, and wx which will be able to carry out these measures to the end, to the complete abolition of bureaucracy, to the introduction of complete democracy for the people.

of capitalism in the USSR. The Albanian comrade Foto Cami says:

"There are three special features which ditinguish the revisionist counter-revolution from the counter-revolutions known up until today.

Differently from other REMINE counterrevolutions, it was not carried out by the firm old former ruling classes overthrown from state power, but by a new bourgeoist class, which was formed gradually in the conditions of socialism as a result of the bourgeois influence from inside and the pressure of imperialism from outside.

It did not begin from below but from above, from the leading cadres of the class which is in power, who degenerated into bourgeois elements and who, for the MENICEMENT achievement of their purposes even used the Party in Power x and the existing x State.

It was not carried out by the use of & armed force but was carried out in a peaceful manner, disguised with socialist phraseology, gradually erroding from within the socialist system . . .

THE RESTORATION OF CAPITALISM AS A MODE OF PRODUCTION. CL denies that capitalism has been restored as a mode of production but says that there is "plenty of capitalism in the Soviet Union." This notion of "plenty of" is completely unscientific and a disgrace to len any pretended Leninist analysis. CL refuses to admit that the means of production function as capital monopolized by a new capitalist class and refuses to recognize that the proletariat has lost ownership and control of the means of production. CL says:

"The Soviet capitalists are faced with the problems of the capitalists of 500 years ago -- that is -- how to accumulate funds into the hands of a few and how to expropriate a freeholding producer and reduce him to the level of a proletarian.

This is nonsense. By seizing the state and changing its class character from proletarian to bourgeois, the Soviet bourgeois took ownership and control of a massive industrial

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base, a banking system, land etc. The main problem facing the new Soviet bourgeoisie is clearly not primary accumulation!

More importantly, the notion that the Soviet worker is a "freeholding producer" rests again on www.www.www.an economist worker's control ideology. CL's idea of expropriation is a clear attack on the x conscious element excax since the proletariat steps forward to take wmmmmmmmmmm ownership and control of the means of production bmx through the dictatorship of the proletariat. Where the bourgeoisie seizes control of the party and the state that is itself an expropriation since the class has been deprived of its vanguard, the instrument through which can exercise its ownership and the class rule to secure that ownership. 1. Supplession of fact

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SOCIAL IMPERIALISM AS A POLICY OR SOCIAL IMPERIALISM AS ANXMEDIATION OF CAPITALISM OF CA

But CL has never said that there is a reference of its conciliation with Boviet revisionism. Breznev and Kosygin we represent a rix clique and not a class which has seized state power, according to CL.

According to CL again the politics of social imperialism are separated from its economics (Kautsky). Social imperialism is the preferred policy of a ruling clique and not the highest stage of capitalism.

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Comrades! The correctness or incorrectness of our political line determines everything. We cannot build a multi-national marxist-leninist Communist Party without a clear and firm line on the restoration of capitalism in the USSR. Nor can we do so without joining the international communist movement in a common front led by the CPC and the PLA in an unrelenting struggle against modern revisionism. Before we can unite, and in order to unite, we must draw strict lines of demarcation between marxism and revisionssm. As the Albanian EMEMBRIENT COMPARISON.
