

# THE YOUTH ARE THE SUCCESSORS OF THE REVOLUTION

We are living in the era of imperialism, the eve of socialist revolution, the International Proletariat and all oppressed peoples have resolutely taken up arms against the bourgeoisie, imperialism and all reaction.

Throughout the world the proletariat under the leadership of the Communist Party of China and the Party of Labor of Albania and the developing Bolshevik Parties have been winning revolutionary and communist youth to the side of the vanguard class and its Party. We have the brilliant examples of the Young Communist League of Russia, under the leadership of Comrades Lenin and Stalin leading the Communist Party of the Soviet Union(B) (CPSU)(B), of the Red Guards in China under the leadership of Chairman Mao and the Communist Party of China (CPC) and in the Youth Labour Union in Albania under the leadership of Comrade Enver Hoxha and the Party of Labor of Albania (PLA).

## Boldness And Courage Of Youth An Inspiration For The Proletariat And Oppressed Masses

Youth who bravely fought against fascism and all reaction under the leadership of the Bolshevik Parties, youth whose boldness and courage was and is an inspiration for the Proletariat and all oppressed peoples.

We have examples in Mexico, where at a massive demonstration against the fascist rule, workers and youth were massacred by the hundreds, to this day many parents have not had any news of some of their children, brothers or sisters because by the next morning after the states snipers had slaughtered the masses they burned the bodies to hide any evidence... without informing any one! In Puerto Rico during the countless clashes with the state trained by the U.S. imperialists workers and youths were killed, imprisoned or exiled. In Thailand last year the newspapers were filled with pictures which depicted a terrible slaughter which had come down on a demonstration of workers and youth. The Thailand bourgeoisie backed by U.S. imperialism had propped up these right wing, fascist, anti-communist elements who with the state (these right wing organizations being riddled with agent provocateurs) had taken and attacked the masses of workers and youth, hanging, maiming and burning them, the masses vigorously fought back. There is the example of the heroic South African youth in Soweto who have given their lives in the struggle for freedom and against the oppressive system of apartheid. "Where there is oppression there is resistance!"

We in the superpowers, U.S. Imperialism and Soviet Social Imperialism, have a great duty to complete. We stand on proletarian internationalism to smash the bourgeois state here, building the U.S. Bolshevik Party to lead the Proletariat who leads all the oppressed masses in making proletarian revolution. The conditions

here are not separate from those faced by the Proletariat and the oppressed masses the world over. Because as the Imperialists carry on their aggression and exploitation internationally the conditions in their own countries for the masses worsen. The crisis of Imperialism is felt everywhere for it is a world wide system.

#### **Conditions For Youth Worsen Under Imperialism**

As a system that is decadent and moribund as Lenin said it is all around us trying to drag the masses down with it, trying to make it's influence day by day more and more felt. The conditions for the class as a whole and specifically for the youth get worse.

The youth face exploitation and oppression as the bourgeoisie tries to take it under its wing. In the schools the repression utilized by the deans and principals, beating and harrassing our youth, racial discrimination and degradation are seen. The bourgeoisie passing laws which allows for the vicious physical attacks on youth (corporal punishment). The bourgeoisie has its prisons filled with youth from the ages of 13 to 21, in fact they make up a good majority

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of the prison inmates. In the Black Belt South there was a case of 4 Black youths who were being raised up on charges of attack which were clearly drummed up to then put them on death row. We stand opposed to youth being imprisoned and the use of capital punishment.

The tracking system which is geared not to the education, development and welfare of our youth but to pushing them through school, leaving them illiterate and trying to stifle their creativity and development. At very young ages, many times still adolescents, youth are forced to drop out. Thereby joining the ranks of the proletariat, whether employed or becoming part of the bourgeoisie's already large reserve army of the unemployed. Capitalism has created its own gravedigger - the proletarit. The swelling of the ranks of the proletariat with youth, the development of future generations of proletarians is a good thing and in the interest of the proletariat. The youth have the right to free, adequate and compulsory education up to the age of 16.

The unemployment among the youth is kept high by the bourgeoisie raising that youth need experience or a skill before working. How can youth gain experience if that experience is kept from them? Many of the factory machines they are taught on in school are so old and outdated that they are not able to use the skills learned in looking for jobs. We stand against the exclusion of youth from production based on lack of experience or skill.

While on the one hand they need these "qualifications", youth when they are hired are put into industries such as the mines, and certain chemical industries which are hazardous to their health, development and welfare. They are used to work on night shifts for 10 to 12 hours a day. This also stifles the development of the youth. We stand opposed to the hiring of youth up to the age of 21 years in industries hazardous to their development and opposed to night work, swing shifts, and forced overtime. Along with these conditions the youth are paid only a certain small percentage of the minimum wage earned by adult workers, thus using them concretely as a source for cheap labor. The youth have the right to be paid the full wage earned by adult workers in the industries they are located. We stand opposed to the exclusion of youth from joining the trade unions and from full participation in organizations such as workers committees. They exclude the youth by using different maneuvers - in one plant youths were excluded from joining the trade union by raising that they were probably there for the summer only "so why join", when the reality was and is that many of the youth who come during the summer to plants, etc., usually remain at those jobs due to the scarcity of the bourgeoisie hiring youth and the need to supplement the money coming into their homes.

Life for the youth as for all the oppressed masses under capitalism is unbearable. In Detroit the unemployment for the youth is the highest in the country and the bourgeois state is trying to lower the outrageous curfew on youth. Presently, at 11 o'clock all the youth have to be home or they and their parents face harrassment and arrests. Now they are trying to lower it to 9 o'clock. The bourgeoisie fears like the plague the force that lies in the youth most especially under the leadership of the proletariat and its Party.

# Oppose Bourgeois Youth Culture Which Pushes Do Your Own Thing

Hand in hand with the oppression and exploitation of working and oppressed youth is the propagation of bourgeois youth culture - here we have the youth, the vast majority unemployed, earning the meagerest of wages, surrounded by the propagation of decadence. An example of this bourgeois decadence is the use of children and youth in pornographic magazines and films - we stand vehemently opposed to the use of children and youth in pornographic films, magazines, newspapers, etc. The bourgeoisie uses the youth for this to make profits off of them, to degrade and demoralize them, to strip them of all their pride. The youth who stand so firm and proud when united under the leadership of its Bolshevik Party and the proletariat. The bourgeoisie prop-

agates through the movies, newspapers, schools, clubs, etc.... "Do your own thing." They are pushed into discotequing all the time, drugs and decadent fashions. They promote competition among the youth on who's the "baddest in hustling", in dressing, etc. It is not incorrect to dress up to date but what the bourgeoisie propagates is for example "punk rock". This is a fascist movement which the bourgeoisie is trying to spread and develop, trying to find a base for it among the upper strata of the petty-bourgeoisie, the right wing of the petty-bourgeoisie. The bourgeoisie slanders the working class youth saying they are into this " punk rock", saying they are a bunch of hippie slobs who go around in ripped jeans held together with safety pins, young girls walking around with just underwear and blouses which is what "punk rock" promotes! Nothing could be further from the truth. This "punk rock" has even been promoting the Nazi symbol swaztika as fashionable! and even naming rock groups "The Dictators ". This is a bunch of hippy freaks who at discos beat each other up! This has nothing in common with the working class youth - no matter what slander the bourgeoisie runs.

The youth are very open to new ideas, for they are young and not yet set in their ways. This the bourgeoisie knows and that's why it so heavily tries to influence them with bourgeois ideology.

### The Youth Are A Reserve Of The Proletariat In Making Proletarian Revolution

But the proletariat is also striving and must win the masses of exploited and oppressed youth under its influence and it can be seen come summer, many youths flock to the plants and factories seeking jobs. Those that are hired try to learn as much as possible from the adult workers. They stand up boldly when they see the tyranny of the bourgeoisie because as youth who have their whole life ahead of them they are fearless. In one factory district the youths gathered in a backyard of a public shoool to have at the end of the week block parties where workers and youth can wage struggle and relax. The school officials and other elements called the police on them to make them leave but they stood firm and united, against the harrassment by the state. The working class and youth do not have recreational facilities to go to the parks that exist in factory districts throughout are inadequate and often more dangerous than the very streets, with faulty equipment. We demand the immediate construction of free and adequate recreation facilities - gymnasiums, theaters, parks, readily accessible to the workers and oppressed masses. For two or three weeks the state harrassed the youth but they never gave an inch. Now, every end of the week workers and youth gather there to struggle, dance and sing. Another particularity that brings them together is the national oppression, for the majority of youth and workers are Puerto Rican, Latin American and Afro-American. As oppressed national minorities they were further drawn together by the out and out racism and national chauvinism of the bourgeoisie, particularly the state.

The bourgeoisie propagates that working and op pressed nationality youth are lumpen, a bunch of sluggards who terrorize the masses. It is the bourgeois state who terrorizes the masses. There are hundreds of incidents where workers and youth have been senselessly beaten or slaughtered. For example the senseless and bloody slaughter of Randolph Evans, Clifford Glover, Claude Reese and Derek Humphrey who were shot down by the police viciously. Another recent example of a senseless murder is in Bridgeport, Connecticut of a young Puerto Rican brother Tito Fernandez. This brother was killed by the police, and the masses justly indignant at this brutal act of tyranny hung an effigy of a policeman and have rallied to protest this savage murder. Yet another example is the murder of Angelo Reyes by police in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania another young Puerto Rican brother viciously shot down leaving behind a wife and six young children, and again the masses are rising to protest this

murder. The Bourgeoisie also props up fascist, right wing, vigilante groups who aid the state in repressing, attacking and even killing youths and proletarians. For example the beatings of Afro American youths by vigilante groups of HassidicJews in Brooklyn. Some of these organizations are formed with the active participation of the Bourgeoisie for example in Brooklyn the vigilante groups of HassidicJews were organized by the owner of a factory who had the audacity to appear on television to brag about how in case of an "emergency", which is to them whenever workers or youth specifically from oppressed nationalities appear in their neighborhoods, all he, the factory owner has to do is put a portable speaker on the roof of his car to mobilize 2,500 HassidicJews to come out to beat them up, as they did to one 16 year old Afro American youth where a car load of Hassidic Jews jumped out of the car and beat him up. We stand resolutely oppossed to these attacks by these Zionist forces, and uphold the right to self-defense.

We stand by the right of the proletariat to bear arms, to fight back against the bourgeoisie who tries to kill us everyday either by starvation, or out and out murder.

PROTESTING THE MURDER OF AFRO -AMERICAN YOUTH - DETROIT, AUGUST 1975

In the high schools we have countless incidents of youth who have walked out in solidarity with the proletariat and its struggle. For example, in an all girls catholic high school where there were communist youth working, giving out propaganda and doing political agitation against the repressive tactics utilized by the teachers, the banning and censorship of communist literature, where 60 girls were suspended from school, the solidarity was welded day by day. We rallied and demonstrated every day in front of the school, youth were mobilized from other public and catholic high schools. The state was called in everyday at times provoking the youths to justify assault on them, the bourgeoisie through the church heads and superintendents tried many maneuvers to scare the youth into

giving up, asking for letters from parents stating they will not rebel again against the school officals. The youth struggled with their parents not to submit the notes. Through the struggle the fighting initiative of the youth was steeled. In mass meetings of the young girls the social props the Mensheviks in particular also played their role, when many revolutionary youth (those youth who unite with the proletarian revolution and are struggling to become communists) stood up in unity with the Marxist-Leninist line fought for by the Revolutionary Wing of the U.S. Anti-Revisionist Communist Movement. The social props propagated that the communist youth were to be "security conscious" and not speak, many times leaving the youth without the support they needed! We stand by the right to have free, adequate, secular and compulsory education for the youth upto the age of 16.

The growing threat of Imperialist war means for the working class and youth their militarist recruitment into the armed forces of the bourgeoisie, for the use of youth as cannon fodder by the bourgeoisie. We stand firm in support of the National Liberation struggles of Latin America, Africa and Asia and opposed to the aggression, exploitation and oppression of the worlds people by the Imperialists and Social Imperialists supported and aided by the comprador bourgeoisie.

These conditions worsen but the bourgeoisie cannot rob the youth of their strength and vigor. Only under the leadership of our Bolshevik Party based on the Proletariat can the initiative and creativity, boldness and courage of our youth be unleashed.

#### Our Party Is Being Born In The Great Class Struggle Of The Proletariat

Our developing Party is being born in the great class struggle of the proletariat against the bourgeoisie, in the struggle to apply Marxism-Leninism to the concrete conditions of the Proletarian Revolution in the U.S., against all forms of opportunism, against modern revisionism.

In the field of work with the youth our Party has much rich experience - indeed it is an honor for our Party that comrades from the ranks of the youth hold positions in all levels of our leadership, it is an honor for our Party to see young comrade workers singing loud and with great pride our Party Building Song ("The World Is In Great Disorder"), it is an honor and an achievement in our work when young comrades with a vigilant eye over our Party advise us to continue to keep our doors tightly shut to the enemy, admitting only the best sons and daughters of the working class. We hold in great pride the influence and authority of our Party which is developing in the fight for the Marxist-Leninist line and we watch with great joy our proletarian children with their fists raised high in the air singing the Internationale. Indeed the youth are the successors of the Proletarian Revolution.

We know that our achievements come as a result of our struggle for the Marxist-Leninist line in our country, battling against opportunism, applying the principle which Comrade Lenin taught us that the struggle against imperialism is a sham and a humbug without a struggle against opportunism.

## Fight For The Marxist-Leninist Line On The Question Of Youth And All Class Questions

We have fought for the Marxist-Leninist line on the class question of youth as on all class questions struggling against such lines as the Young Bolshevik League (YBL) should not be under the leadership of our Party - the propagation of the Menshevik line of "neutrality" for the mass organizations - liquidating the independence and initiative, in fact the vanguard role of the Party, surrendering the hegemony of the proletariat to that of the bourgeoisie. In a class society each class struggles for its interests, and everything

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is stamped with the brand of a class, for nothing escapes the class struggle. In our society where the principle and fundamental contradiction is between the capitalist class and the working class, these two classes are in constant battle, and our Party must fight every inch of the way for its very existence, it is a bitter struggle to establish and develop the influence and authority of our Party which represents the interests of the working class and no other class. Our Party guides the Young Bolshevik League, as it guides all the organizations of the proletariat. This line which rejects and attacks the leadership of our Party reflects the liquidationist trend in the Anti-Revisionist Communist Movement, that trend which liquidates the

The fight for the vanguard role of the Party has been a historic one in the mass youth organizations such as the Puerto Rican Student Union (PRSU) and February First Movement (FFM), the struggle against the line of anti-imperialism as a third ideology, against the line that Marxism-Leninism should not be studied in mass organizations dates back to 1971, when comrades from PRSU struggling against revisionism, stood firm on the verdict of the international communist movement that in fact capitalism had been restored in the Soviet Union, that revisionism has state power and that the once glorious USSR was no longer the dictatorship of the proletariat, comrades stood firm against the revisionist betrayal of the Communist Parties in the capitalist countries and in our country of the CPUSA, reaffirming Marxism-Leninism as the guiding ideology.

But the revisionist line of anti-imperialism as a third ideology, attacking the vanguard role of Marxism-Leninism and the vanguard role of our Party reflecting Right Opportunism as the main danger continued to raise its ugly head and in the battles against it we have scored victories. Indeed it would be an absurdity for us to hear in our ranks today such lines as the YBL should not be under the leadership of our Party or that mass organizations such as the YBL should be anti-imperialist.

The fight for the Marxist-Leninist line on Party organizations has indeed shed clarity on all the muddle that the opportunists introduced into our ranks about the YBL being a Party organization - for in this fight we have reaffirmed the Marxist-Leninist principle that the YBL is a non-party mass communist organization (see polemic Bolshevik, Vol. 6 #11 "In The Fight For The Party Build the Young Bolshevik League"). In this fight we have reaffirmed that the basic unit of the YBL is the factory nuclei - a unity which was reached long ago on the Party Building Commission (PBC) but which was sabotaged by the opportunists and secret political police specifically Paul Sanders.

#### Draft The Program Of The Young Bolshevik League

Flowing from the consistent fight for the key link to Party Building - the hammering out of our Party's basic line and Program of Action, we have arrived at the truth that the most important task we face in building the YBL, in keeping with our central task Party Building, is that we must draft the Program of the YBL.

In struggling over this we have united that the Program of the YBL must state clearly its unity with the line and Program of the U.S. Bolshevik Party, it must state clearly that it is a non-party communist organization fighting for the smashing of the bourgeois state and the establishment of the dictatorship of the proletariat and that its final aim is the complete abolition of classes - communism, it must in unity with the Program of the Party be a declaration of war with the bourgeoisie, expressing and standing resolute on the proletarian internationalist character of our struggle that of doing "the utmost possible in one country for the development and awakening of the revolution in all countries" by fighting our "own" U.S. bourgeoisie. It must reaffirm the vanguard role of the proletariat as the only revolutionary class.

It must clearly and precisely sum-up the objective conditions which face the youth flowing from the component parts of the Party Program which clearly includes:

- "1. An analysis of the basic features of the development and decline of U.S. Imperialism.
- 2. A definite statement on the inevitable results on this state of decay and decline the general political and economic crisis of imperialism which results in more deprivation and poverty and the developing mass uprising and indignation of the proletariat." (Bolshevik - Mayday Supplement)

On this question of the conditions of the youth the Draft Program of the Young Communist League (YCL) clearly states:

> "Capital exploits the small amount of defensive strength of the working class youth, and squeezes special profits out of the cheaper and for the employer, more advantageous labour of the youth. Long working hours, out of all proportion, which, in spite of the immature bodily development and weaker stamina of the youth, and the necessity for their mental development, often exceed the working hours of adult workers, wages disproportionately low in comparison with those of adult workers, although the work is done equal to theirs, night work, work in factories injurious to health, barbaric treatment at the hands of the employers, unemployment without support and its consequences (sinking into misery, prostitution, crime) - that is the lot of the working youth under the domination of capitalism." (Draft Program of the Young Communist

League -(1924?)

Its tactical line must include demands on the questions of unemployment of youth, night work, shifts, forced overtime and work in industries specifically injurious to the health of youth, standing opposed to the discrimination against youth in hiring, firing and joining unions. It must include demands for the free, adequate and secular education up to the age of 16, for free and adequate health and recreation facilities . It must expose the bourgeois youth culture, which propagates anit-communism and which sucks the youth into gambling, drugs, alcohol and pornography - expose the utilization of children and youth for pornography and prostitution exposing all the corruption of the capitalist system. It must expose the utilization of the youth as cannon fodder in imperialist wars and their recruitment into fascist organizations such as the Moonies, Hare Krishna, ROTC, Cadets, Nazi Party and KKK Klan Youth Corps as well. It must expose the savage brutality of the state on the youth, capital punishment, beatings, harrassment and the prison system as well as the courts which railroad the youth to reform schools, mental institutions and jails, and denounce the recently passed law allowing the corporal punishment of youth in school. It must uphold the right of the youth and the entire working class to bear arms.

Comrades, in order to draft the Program of the YBL we have taken as our guide the Draft Program of the Young Communist International and the Program of the Young Communist International. Much more study, struggle and hard work is needed - indeed our ties with the masses of youth must be strengthened and on this question all is not well. Both Right and "Left" deviations away from the Marxist-Leninist line have caused great harm in our work.

The Acting Central Committee (ACC) has summed up that comrades have not been resolutely raising the political struggle to comrade youths, not arming them with the polemics, with an understanding of the historic fight for our Party, but rather "hanging out" with them as if one were an ordinary non-communist reflecting the Right deviation, belittling the role of theory and the conscious element and overemphasizing the objective factor. This undermines the revolutionary youth who unite with Proletarian Revolution and who are struggling to become communists. It negates that these revolutionary youth are seeking the guidance and leadership in the struggle which only the Party can give them. It negates that the youth want to learn communism, want to study Marxism-Leninism and are eager to apply it to solve the concrete problems of the U.S. revolution. It negates the leadership that our Party must give to the work with youth and to the development and growth of the Young Bolshevik League. Comrade Stalin taught us this about the role of the Party in giving leadership to all the organizations of the proletariat:


"3) The Party as the highest form of class organization of the proletariat. The Party is the organized detachment of the working class. But the Party is not the only organization of the working class. The proletariat has also a number of other organizations, without which it cannot wage a successful struggle against capital: trade unions, co-operatives, factory organizations, parliamentary groups, non-Party women's associations, the press, cultural and educational organizations, youth leagues, revolutionary fighting organizations (in times of open revolutionary action), Soviets of deputies as the form of state organization (if the proletariat is in power), etc. The overwhelming majority of these organizations are non-Party, and only some of them adhere directly to the Party, or constitute offshoots from it. All these organizations, under certain conditions, are absolutely necessary for the working class, for without them it would be impossible to consolidate the class positions of the proletariat in the diverse spheres of struggle; for without them it would be impossible to steel the proletariat as the force whose mission it is to replace the bourgeois order by the socialist order. But how can single leadership be exercised with such an abundance of organizations? What guarantee is there that this multiplicity of organizations will not lead to divergency in leadership? It may be said that each of these organizations carries on its work in its own special field, and that therefore these organizations cannot hinder one another. That, of course, is true. But it is also true that all these organizations should work in one direction for they serve one class, the class of the proletarians. The question then arises: who is to determine the line, the general direction, along which the work of all these organizations is to be conducted? Where is the central organization which is not only able, because it has the necessary experience, to work out such a general line, but, in addition, is in a position, because it has sufficient prestige, to induce all these organizations to carry out this line, so as to attain unity of leadership and to make hitches impossible?

That organization is the Party of the proletariat."

(<u>Selected Writings</u> - J.V. Stalin,pgs.124-125)

The Right is the main danger we face however the "Left" deviation has also manifested itself in talking at the youth and not with them, running off at the mouth, not listening to the youth, investigating the conditions they face - overemphasizing the subjective factor. This deviation has been reflected in viewing youth involved with drugs as "lumpen" and making this the main point of struggle with them. It has been manifested in viewing youth who join the military as "fascist." Therefore negating the conditions which force the youth into the military, and how the training of the youth in the military can and must be used in the interests of the proletariat. Comrade Stalin has taught us this about strengthening the ties of the Party with the masses:

"But the Party cannot be only an advanced detachment. It must at the same time be a detachment of the class, part of the class, closely bound up with it by all the fibers of its being. The distinction between the advanced detachment and the rest of the working class, between Party members and non-Party people, cannot disappear until classes disappear; it will exist as long as the ranks of the proletariat continue to be replenished with former members of other classes, as long as the working class as a whole is not in a position to rise to the level of the advanced detachment. But the Party would cease to be a party if this distinction developed into a gap, if the Party turned in on itself and became divorced from the non-Party masses. The Party cannot lead the class if it is not connected with the non-Party masses, if there is no bond between the Party and the non-Party masses, if these masses do not accept its leadership, if the Party enjoys no moral and political credit among the masses. " (Selected Writings - J.V. Stalin, pg. 121)

We must guard against both Right and "Left" deviations by persevering in the struggle for the Marxist-Leninist line in our country. We must guard against one tendency covering another - for instance on the question of "youth gangs" - the bourgeoisie propagates that all youth are hoodlums and belong to gangs. This is nothing but the contemptuous view of the bourgeoisie - however, in struggling against this if we blame it all on the objective conditions we would negate that youth who join such gangs consciously do so and must be held accountable to the working class. If we say no such thing as youth gangs exist it would be like covering our eyes and saying the sky does not exist, it just is not true.

Youth gangs exist - they are a minority of corrupted elements who harrass, rip off, intimidate and many times kill other youths and proletarians. The working class is opposed to these gangs and rightfully so! The majority of the youth contrary to what the bourgeoisie pushes do not belong to gangs - but rather many times have joined together in social clubs, sports teams, or com-

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munity groups and factory groups many times to struggle against the conditions they face whether it be broken down streets and houses, drug pushers in the community, no recreation centers or not being able to join the trade unions, harrassment on the job by foremen or for the purpose of socializing and sports. This is as different as night and day from the youth gangs.

#### The Sham Wing In The Service Of The Bourgeoisie Disarms The Masses Of Youth

Comrades, in the service of the bourgeoisie the Sham Wing of the U.S. Anti-Revisionist Communist Movement, revisionists old and new disarm the masses of youth with their program of reforms, never raising the consciousness of the youth. They pave the way for fascism by propagating the line of least resistance "They say cutback, we say fightback", centering the struggle of the youth exclusively on the college campuses and the economic issues, they attack the struggle to insure the proletarian core of the Young Bolshevik League as they are incapable of this. In fact their line speaks not to organizing the working class, oppressed nationality, high school and college student youth but solely college students and professors.

A clear example of this is August Twentyninth Movement (ATM) and Resistencia (LPR"ML") who have been propping up and trying desperately to give credibility to the "struggle at Brooklyn Collège" propagating the most narrow, realisable demands - "special admissions programs, financial aid programs and ethnic studies" (June 77 - Revolutionary Cause) and in this case covering up the work of the secret political police, specifically the agent provocateur Richie Perez and his band of provocateurs operating out of Brooklyn College.

Workers Viewpoint Organization (WVO) is another example pushing that the struggle of youth is for "quality education, socially productive jobs" and throwing in at the end "exploitation and repression." (Revolutionary Youth Newspaper of the Revolutionary Youth League)

The future of the youth is inseperably bound to the future of the proletariat - the class that is growing and developing with each passing day. The youth are the successors of the revolution, their struggle as reserves of the proletariat is to construct a new socialist order, to smash the bourgeois state and establish the dictatorship of the proletariat - (the working class organized as the ruling class) build socialism and onward to classless society - communism. "What a bright future lies ahead for all the young masses!" (They Stand Erect and Tall) But Revolutionary Youth League - W.V.O. limits the struggle to reforming the conditions under capitalism "quality education, socially productive jobs." They try to fool the masses by pushing that jobs under capitalism are "socially productive" when under capitalism what is produced is for the bourgeoisie, it is under socialism that labor becomes socially productive.

The Program of the Young Communist International states:

"The establishment of the socialist society demands and makes possible, a complete change in the conditions of youth labour. The socialist re-organization of youth labour is the linking up of productive work with training and education, and the entire transformation of youth labour from the viewpoint and with the aim of training fully developed members of the socialist society. Because of this, socialism replaces wage labour for the youth by social maintenance.

This aim was pointed out to us by the great teachers of the proletariat, Marx and Lenin. Marx said:

'In the factory system we have the embryo of the education of the future which will combine productive work with tuition and gymnastics for all children over a certain age, not only as a method of increasing social production, but as the only method of bringing up fully developed human beings.'
Lenin taught us:

It is impossible to visualise the ideal future society without linking up for the young generation the process of production work and education. Neither training and education without productive work, no productive work without training, can reach the level required by modern technical development and scientific knowledge."

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By propagating that under capitalism the struggle is for "socially productive jobs" WVO liquidates the dictatorship of the proletariat and the construction of socialism.

The O.L. "Communist Party""ML" also makes a mockery of the struggle of the youth with their Romper-Room "Childrens Corner" and their paper the Young Communist. They also push that the struggle of youth is for the most narrow economic, reformist demands. In faking a polemic with the revisionist "CP"USA and its revisionist youth organization the Young Workers Liberation League they say that the "CP"USA "divert youth away from the struggle for their right to a job (our emph., ed.) and against imperialism." (The Young Communist, June 1977)

Six of one and half a dozen of the other! Both the "CP"USA and "CP""ML" sniveling right behind them divert the struggle of youth away from the struggle for <u>fundamental</u> change - a new socialist order! Both push that the struggle is for reform - "jobs" as both revise all the fundamental principles of Marxism - Leninism Mao Tse Tung Thought.

All the Sham forces have bombarded the youth with ragsheet youth newspapers. Taking Young Red by R"CP" as another example in issue No. 2 this is how they revise the need for class struggle:

"If you're goint to eat, have any boy friends, girl friends and a family -- then you're going to have to have to deal with the society you live in."

Talk about the most palpable demands - this is the lowest of the low - vulgar materialism without a doubt! These forces talk to the youth as if they were fools - but the hard life under capitalism makes the youth wise for their young years and this patronizing foolishness - this utter revision of the class struggle, of MLMTT cannot get over. In this same issue they printed an article entitled - "What Is Communism?"

"Is it This?

Natasha and Boris slinking around in their dark glasses and trenchcoats stealing military secrets. Or sneaky men and women who try to sucker innocent American youth and brainwash them to be robots for revolution.

Trying to take control of the government and set up a society where everyone dresses alike (in very grey overalls), thinks exactly alike, slaving in factories 12 hours a day for some dictators.

Where it's a federal crime to own a T-Shirt because there's no private property...

WELL NO, THAT'S NOT WHAT COMMUNISTS STAND FOR."

This is straight up anti-communism under the sign-board of communism. It sounds like a document from the House Un - American Activities Committee! This is the line of all reaction, all the enemies of communism the world over - distorting and slandering the world wide struggle of the proletariat for its final aim the abolition of classes- communism.

All the sham forces and their ragsheet newspapers reflect their contempt for the youthtalking to the youth like Sesame Street, never giving the youth the respect they deserve. Genuine Communists teach the youth Communism not by revising it but by fighting for the Marxist-Leninist line, standing resolute on principle, fighting in practice in the interests of the oppressed and exploited masses, summing up their experiences, imbuing them with discipline and organization and making them class conscious fighters of the proletariat. Bringing the youth under the wise eye, open heart and strong arm of the Party which trains them for the bright future.

### The Revolutionary Wing In The Interests Of The Proletariat - Calls A Nationwide Youth Conference

In order to combat all the treachery of the Sham Wing, in order to carry out our internationalist duty we must be ever more resolute in our struggle to build our Party, building the Young Bolshevik League in the course of that struggle.

Comrades, the Revolutionary Wing of the U.S. Anti-Revisionist Communist Movement is preparing for a nation-wide Youth Conference to outline the tasks to draft the Program of the Young Bolshevik League, in keeping with Party building our central task and building the revolutionary non-party mass organizations. The organization of the youth is a very crucial task which our developing Party has before it, in this area of work we have much rich experience from Youth Organization for Black Unity (YOBU), Third World Student League (TWSL), Puerto Rican Student Union (PRSU), Black Anti-Imperialist Student Caucus (BAISC), and Revolutionary Youth Collective (RYC), to our present day work in building the YBL.

The fight for the Marxist-Leninist line on this class question will be represented at a higher level in the Program of the Young Bolshevik League (YBL). 
