



TRIKE U.S. Out of S.E. Asia Stop the Bombings

IN THE PAST WEEK AND A HALF, Nixon and friends have sent literally hundreds of planes - including B-52's - in raids against the north Vietnamese people. They boast about bombing the big port of Haiphong and the capital, Hanoi. Pilots say they're told "drop the bombs anywhere if the target is hard to find". In other words, any and all Vietnamese are targets of this attack. The U.S. government is using the massive raids to scare the Vietnamese people so they'll stop fighting back. But that's never worked in Vietnam, or anywhere else, and it isn't working now.

THE U.S. GOVERNMENT USED TO TALK all the time about the justice of its cause in vietnam. By now nearly everyone is against the government in this war. So we don't hear too much nowadays about the "justice of the U.S. government's cause". The cold fact is: the war is being fought to benefit a few rich corporations. And the U.S. isn't about to get out of Vietnam until it's forced out. Millions of Vietnamese workers and peasants are organizing right now to defeat the escalation and drive the U.S. out of Vietnam - and all of southeast Asia. SDS calls on everyone to back the Vietnamese people in this truly. The source of international struggle against those who are oppressed. That's why we're CALLING A MILITANT STUDENT STRIKE, in every school, in every COUNTRY, where it's possible. The main demants: U.S. OUT OF SOUTHEAST ASIA - NOW !!

STOP THE BOMBINGS!

Students should shut down all high schools and colleges. Try to win workers to strike too. Hold meetings where students and workers can discuss politics and strategy together. Set up picket lines around the schools - this is no time for business as usual!

WE SHOULD EXPOSE AND ATTACK the ways in which the schools are linked up with the war. For instance, ROTC must go! (There could be <u>sit-ins</u> at ROTC buildings and also other militant actions). No war recruiters! That goes for Dow, GM, GE and other big "defense" contractors too, not just armed forces. Kick them off wherever they appear, End'all war research! Why should we let them use the schools to figure out better ways to kill the Vietnamese? End university complicity in the oppression of people in Africa, Latin America, Asia and elsewhere. Like Harvard's ownership of stocks in Gulf OII, a company that helps the rich Portuguese shaft the African people.

We should raise other issues, too. It's especially important to fight CAMPUS RACISM. The government is behind a big campaign to push racist ideas any way they can in order to justify their racist practices. We should fight against racist texts and professors and the harassment and racist flunkouts black and latin students face.

WHEN YOUR SCHOOL GOES OUT ON STRIKE, struggle with people to stay at school. Keep the schools shut down and spread the strike! There can be MASS DISCUSSIONS of how best to oppose the war and racism. Produce LEAFLETS and get them out to other schools as well as working class communities and factories. SPREAD THE STRIKE - to other schools - but also to workers. Working people can stop this war by striking nationwide! Plan joint actions with workers on campus and off campus. Stage massive demonstrations against local war-related institutions, recruitment centers, federal buildings, etc. Give U.S. diplomats and Nixon and his fellow racist war criminals the treatment they deserve.

MAY DAY is an international holiday that first started as a commemoration of heroic workers who died fighting for the 8-hour day in Chicago's Haymarket Square in 1886. People all over the world celebrate this as a symbol of working people's fight against oppression - and thousands will look to see what happens in the U.S. This demonstration raising international solidarity, U.S. out of Southeast Asia now and anti-racism will be a powerful call for a movement founded on INTERNATIONALISM.

THE SDS CONVENTION involved a vast number of people of different nationalities and races. The focus was against the war and racism, and for internationalism. There was much leadership from minority students. This convention was truly a first inter-racial, international convention. The MAY DAY marches will be another big step forward for INTER-NATIONALISM!



PART OF THE GROUP of over 2,000 who took part in the March 30-April 2 SDS Convention at Harvard. The convention was held despite intense harassment from Harvard. The most striking feature was the way the large numbers of black, white, asian, latin an native-american students and non-students worked together, hashed out all sorts of questions about the anti-racism fight, and came up with over 60 resolutions. How to Build the Strike Here are some ideas on how to build the strike for STOP THE BOMBINGS and U.S. OUT OF SOUTHEAST ASIA NOW in your area.

I. FORM AN SDS CHAPTER if there is none yet. If one exists, it should meet, SDS is an international, multi-racial militant student group against the war and racism. You can form a chapter anywhere, as long as you agree with the demands around the war and fighting racism. You don't need "permission" or something. Please let us know if you're starting a chapter - we'll help as well as we can. Write us at any local address, or the Boston national headquarters address.

2. WHEREVER POSSIBLE, pull together an SDS Regional Interim Committee - which unites the work of different chapters.

3. The RIC's should work out a plan, or individual chapters could do it, to build the strikes. (If SDS isn't around, it's best if some group does this!). Call together other groups on campus (or off!) who want to build the strike. Call meetings based on demands to STOP THE BOMBINGS and U.S. OUT OF SOUTHEAST ASIA NOW! But if possible, link anti-racist demands to the anti-war demands. Focus on ways in which the schools are tied in with the "war effort". WHEREVER THIS IS AGREED ON, STRIKE COMMITTEES SHOULD ENDORSE THE VERY IMPORTANT MAY DAY MARCHES AGAINST THE WAR AND RACISM.

4. THEN you can either call a strike right away, or after building for awhile. You have to judge based on local conditions. When you DO call a strike, the best idea is MASS PICKET LINES TO REALLY SHUT IT DOWN. But everyone shouldn't go right home - because that would just empty out the schools. That would hurt the fight. Strike - but stay on campus and keep up the struggle.

5. Here are some ideas for building for a strike - they are also good things to do after the strike gets called: take out faculty ads in local college and non-college media; sponsor teach-ins; panel discussions, debates, workshops on what to do and why; call for and organize militant confrontations (how militant depends on what people are ready to do - it's different in different places) against war-related institutions - like ROTC, war research labs, government officials; contact faculty and CAMPUS WORKERS (also off-campus working people and professionals) about taking support action - OR STRIKING THEMSELVES.

6. Tie strike into struggles against school budget cuts, laying-off of campus workers, male chauvinist firings of workers or teachers, etc.


