THEY SHALL NOT PASS!

Since the Federal Member for Ipswich, Pauline Hansen delivered her maiden speech in the House of Representatives, the monopoly press of Murdoch-Packer-Black, have given her more than 200 mentions a day. In addition the red-neck radio talk back programmes, whose social function is to fan resentment and damage the reputation of people on Welfare supposedly ripping off the system., are having a field day.

Hansen's speech, claiming to be speaking for 'ordinary Australians', railed against unemployment, crime, drugs, privatization of Telstra and Qantas, financial markets, foreign aid, and blamed it all on Asian migration and the money given to the Aboriginal people.

The monopoly press is busy whipping up a storm of resentment against Asians and Aboriginals, making sure that there is no enlightened debate around the other issues raised by Hansen.

The people are taking to the streets in opposition to the fascist racist ideas of Hansen and have demonstrated in most cities including the electorate of Ipswich. Leaders of ethnic communities are taking a front position.

The Parliamentary parties have issued a general statement of opposition full of political platitudes.

Under the leadership of these bourgeois serving parties the Australian people are rightly worried at the direction Australia is taking. There is growing division between the rich and poor, hard won gains are being legislated away, unemployment faces a youth without hope of the future, homelessness, suicide and poverty and rising prices for the necessities of life. Health and education is being rapidly privatized.

Hansen, backed by the bourgeois press, is preparing the way to replace the genuine anger of the people with dangerous divisions according to race.

Hansen is a nonentity as was the Austrian paper hanger of the 1930's. It is the imperialist bourgeoisie who use these people to save their own skins by whipping up a frenzy of diversion against the real anxieties of the people. They shift the blame for the rotting social system on to the backs of the most oppressed; the migrants and the Aboriginal people

Racist division had always been the tool of the ruling class when their class position is threatened from the wrath of the people. The ruling class is spending millions in re-organizing the Armed forces of the state in preparation for a show down with the workers who are finding new forms of struggle outside the old forms of trade unions and parliament. In these new forms of struggle, workers born in Australia and outside are fighting together. When a group broke down the door of parliament, women, Aboriginals, blue and white collar workers battled together. This sent a warning to the bourgeoisie.

The parliamentary parties in Canberra are representatives of the imperial bourgeoisie. The fascism they half heartedly condemn is the principal product of their class. The fascism of 50 years ago was also a product of the imperial bourgeoisie. The bourgeoisie, in and out of parliament, in occupied Europe made deals with the Nazis, they watched fascism go through one country after another, they watched the Hitlerite persecution and extermination of the communists, democrats, the Gypsies and the Jews without firing a shot, some absconded abroad: the only price they paid was a limitation on their profits.

These same representatives of the ruling class waved flags at the 50th anniversary of the end of World War 11 and the defeat of Fascism. They never mentioned that Fascism was defeated on Soviet soil with the blood of 24 million These same representatives of the bourgeoisie watch the growth of fascism all over Europe today and fill their mouths with platitudes.

Victory over Fascisn, Racism and the Bourgeoisie belongs to the anti-imperialist people of the world. The people marching in Australian cities belong to this great army of honour.

At the end of Clinton's speech, "May God bless Australia, the United states, and the great friendship between our nations"

After the usual Koala cuddling, the round of golf with Greg Norman, the street walks to smile and shake hands with the people, both national leaders departed for the Philipinnes to the Asia Pacific Economic Co-operation Conference (APEC).

When we sweep away the imperialisr rhetoric (called bullshit here) the truth is that at the APEC conference the knives will be out as the imperialists set about carving up the Asia-Pacific region for greater profit, more exploitation and more oppression. The imperialists will fight over everything to the last dollar and cent. What they will agree on is how much blood they can squeeze from the labour of the workers, and how best to attack the proletarian organizations.

APEC is part of the imperialist re-grouping against their economic rivals. Make no mistake, these economic rivals will resort to war to crush their opponents.

When the APEC conference opened it was met by massive demonstrations of the Philipino people. The banners of the demonstrators showed that the people fully understand the objectives of the APEC conference. low wages, greater exploitation.

Along with the economic war against the people of the region, the APEC conference will plan the military exercises, the training of military personel, establishing of military bases and the rest and recreation of the Yankee troops All this has already been agreed to between the USA and Australia.

The Australian bourgeoisie are hitching their wagon to the USA for crumbs. In fact, they will not receive any crumbs because the USA is not out to share the spoils with anyone.
