Now is the time for the Australian Government to =

- 1 Recognize East Timor as an Independent nation;
- 2. Cancel the agreement between Australia and Indonesia which recognizes Indonesian sovereignty over East Timor.
- 3. Scrap the 10 year agreement between Australia and Indonesia governing the exploration of the oil and gas fields in the Timor Gap.
- 4. STOP the training of Indonesian soldiers in Australia, stop arms exports, all military "aid" and military exercises with Indonesia.
- 5. Withdraw Australia's Ambassador in Indonesia.
- 6. Pressure Australian Big Business to get out of Indonesia.

THE IMPERIALIST AUSTRALIAN GOVERNMENT HAS ALWAYS BETRAYED THE PEOPLE OF EAST TIMOR.

1945 During World War 11, 40,000 Timorese lost their lives because they supported the Australians against the Japanese. The soldiers assured the Timorese that the Australian Government would help them for their service and sacrifice. The Australian Government never honoured these promises.

1965. The Suharto fascist regime murdered 1--2 million Indonesians; the Communists (PKI) and members of democratic organizations. The names of the victims was supplied to the fascists by the CIA and ASIO. The Australian Government sat on its hands.

1975. Indonesia invaded East Timor. The five Australian Journalists were killed. The slaughter of the Timorese people began. 200,000 or a third of the population has been killed since 1975. The East Timorese have fought with arms in hand for 25 years.

The Australian Government recognized Indonesian sovereignty over East Timor. The only government in the world to do so. Not even the UN did so.

1989. Australia and Indonesia signed a 10 year Agreement to carve up the oil and gas in the Timot Sea. Remember the photograph of Foreign Minister (ALP) Evans and Indonesian officials laughing, shaking hands and sipping champagne as they clinched the deal.

1999. Now that East Timor is an independent nation, this deal no longer stands.
