- 1.** Destruction of the fascist state and establishment of a democratic and popular republic, under democratic and popular dictatorship, that is to say under the joint dictatorship of all the revolutionary classes, and under the dictatorship of the proletariat.
- 2.** Nationalization without compensation, by the people's democratic power, of companies under foreign control. Nationalization of banks, insurance companies, mines, iron and steel, metallurgy and metallurgy, transport and communications, electric power, water resources, chemical industry and all enterprises of national interest. People's democratic power will safeguard the interests of small and medium shareholders who have not fomented counter-revolutionary activities.
- 3.** Confiscation of the lands of the large agrarians, large agrarians and other counter-revolutionaries; and handing over these lands to the agricultural proletariat and the poor peasantry, according to the principle:

“The land to whom works it. » Transfer of “baldios” (communal land) to popular peasant associations or unions.
- 4.** Separation and complete independence for the brother peoples of the colonies. Return of the soldiers, not a single boarding. Immediate and unconditional return of Macao to the sovereignty of the Republic of China.
- 5.** Safeguarding national sovereignty and defending national independence. Publication and denunciation of all secret treaties. Cancellation of the unequal treaties imposed by the imperialists and the social-imperialists. Dismantling and withdrawal of foreign military bases and forces. Establishment of relations of friendship and cooperation with all the peoples of the world.
- 6.** Creation of a popular democratic school and a new, patriotic, scientific and mass culture.
- 7.** The 40-hour week and the welfare of the people.
