STATEMENT OF POLICY

1. The Britain-Vietnam Solidarity Front (B.V.S.F.) unreservedly and resolutely supports the national rights of the Vietnamese people for peace, independence, sovereignty and territorial integrity of their fatherland — rights recognised by the 1954 Geneva Agreements.

2. The B.V.S.F. resolutely supports the revolutionary people's war of the three Indo-Chinese peoples of Vietnam, Laos and Cambodia against U.S. imperialism and its puppets for their national liberation, according to the historic Declaration of the Indo-Chinese People's Summit Conference of April, 1970.

The Declaration, a programmatic document, represents a historic stage in the united struggle of the heroic Indo-Chinese peoples for national salvation and for complete victory over the U.S. aggressors and their lackeys. It is an important contribution to the struggle of the people of Asia as well as the world people against U.S. imperialism.

3. The B.V.S.F. extends unreserved support to the 7-point peace proposal along with the 2-point elaboration submitted by the Provisional Revolutionary Government of the Republic of South Vietnam at the Paris talks. These proposals correspond to the programme of the South Vietnam National Front for Liberation, for liberating the South, defending the North and proceeding to the re-unification of Vietnam.

4. The B.V.S.F. vehemently condemns and resolutely opposes the Nixon doctrine of "Vietnamization," "Khyberization," and "Imperialism" of the U.S. war which is aimed at turning Indo-China into a U.S. neo-colony and base of aggression against the Asian people, particularly China. This plot of U.S. imperialism is doomed to an ignominious failure.

5. The B.V.S.F. sternly condemns the continued escalation of U.S. aggression and all acts of war ag'inst the Democratic Republic of Vietnam. The sovereignty, territory and air-space of the Democratic Republic of Vietnam are inviolable. Vietnam, North and South, is one country. The Vietnamese people are one people and have the unalienable right to fight together and support each other for defeating the aggressors.

6. The B.V.S.F. resolutely opposes the reactionary policies of the British ruling class, whether represented by the Tory or Labour Governments, who are aiding and abetting U.S. policies of aggression in Indo-China and other countries, whilst at the same time, attacking the living standards and democratic rights of the British working people — all in order to safeguard and perpetuate the profits of the monopoly capitalists.

The B.V.S.F. extends resolute support to the mounting struggles of the working people in the defence and advancement of their interests and against the treachery of the "Labour" and so-called working class leaders who serve to perpetuate capitalist rule over the working people through the parliamentary fraud.

In order to achieve the unity of the militant youth and students with the working class struggle, the B.V.S.F. shall support the struggle for democratic education, cultural and sports facilities, and democratic liberties.

The B.V.S.F. resolutely opposes national and racial oppression, and it firmly supports the struggle for the unity of the working class against the conspiracy to split and divide it on racial or national lines. For this it will wage a consistent struggle for equal democratic rights for all people, irrespective of race, colour or national origin. The B.V.S.F. resolutely supports the struggle of the Irish people for a united, democratic people's republic of Ireland.

7. The B.V.S.F. will fight to win the British people to an understanding of their common interest with the oppressed peoples of Asia, Africa and Latin America in their struggle against colonialism, neo-colonialism and imperialism headed by the United States and Soviet social imperialism.

8. The B.V.S.F. shall campaign for the unity and solidarity of the British people with the world-wide movement of opposition to the domination of the two super-powers and to support the national liberation movements and the struggle for peace and social advance.
