Several new incidents of right-wing threats following the Los Angeles bombing have been reported to the National Office in the past week:

A Los Angeles television station was bombed the day it was scheduled to show two Cuban films. A Klan group demonstrated in front of the Houston SWP branch headquarters wearing robes and carrying rifles following a favorable editorial on the Starsky case in the morning daily paper. They dispersed before cops arrived. In Boston swastikas were painted on the SWP headquarters door. There have been phone threats from self-proclaimed Nazis in Minneapolis and from "anonymous citizens" in Portland.

Leading comrades in the branches should be made aware that these incidents may indicate a national wave of ultra-rightest threats directed toward us. It should be watched closely and even small incidents immediately reported to the N.O.

There will be an initial article on these incidents in this week's Militant.
