



Shanges in Total Monthly Sustainer Pledged to National Office Since December 1974



In December, 1974, a national campaign was launched to increase the total sustainer pledged to the national office by \$1,000 per month by August. We achieved more than double this goal. The total increase by August was \$2312, of which \$1552 came from increases in per capita pledges from nineteen branches, and \$760 was the result of the party's growth in membership since December.


The formation of new branches resulted in a drop of \$1950 in September. However, we have recovered \$1185 of this loss: \$568 is from per capita sustainer increases from eight branches, and \$617 is the result of the party's growth this fall.




