Dear comrades,

After nearly one year of internal and partially public debate on the perspectives for the Swedish section's work in the Latin American exile milieu (which has been coupled to very serious organizational disputes between the two groupings as well as between both these groupings and the leadership of the section) a majority of our Latin American fraction have left the Swedish section. These comrades have regrouped themselves as an association which they define as a sympathizing group to the Swedish section and the FI. The associated has proposed that the section recognizes them as a sympathizing group as well as common work in the exile community. So far we have only tried to discuss the political incorrectness of their step in the hopes of getting them to return to the section to participate in the last stages of the debate which should lead to a decision of the Central Committee in June.

Unfortunately, the comrades who have left the section include the entire editorial board of Combate. In this situation it is impossible for the section to continue the publication of Combate in the immediate future. However, the comrades in the association plan to continue the publication of their own. Obviously the section can take no responsibility for the publication in these circumstances.

The situation is extremely unclear at the moment. We are trying to avoid any move which could mean a definite break with these comrades while we obviously must oppose their step and wage a political battle to bring them back to the section. We will keep you informed of further developments.
