1. NUCLEAR POWER

<u>Weissberg</u> reported on recent demonstrations in the United States against nuclear power and nuclear weapons, some of which were the largest actions around this issue to date. He indicated the dates of some of the more important actions and conferences coming up. Among these are a demonstration at the United Nations on May 27 against nuclear weapons and for disarmament organized by the Mobilization for Survival; a demonstration in Seabrook, New Hampshire, on June 24; and a Southeast antinuclear conference called by the Tallahassee Catfish Alliance for May 27 and 28. We will participate in the Tallahassee conference and support the Catfish Alliance's call for a national day of antinuclear demonstrations in the fall.

<u>D. Jenness</u> reported on an international antinuclear conference of Trotskyists held in Europe which discussed the outline of an international statement against nuclear power and the possibilities of an international day of protest.
