4) Post Office - Total 12. There are 11 in CUPW and 1 in LCUC. Fractions composed of comrades in the following cities: Montreal 1, Winnipeg 1, Edmonton 6, Vancouver 4. Number of women 4.
5) Wood - Total 12. All in Vancouver. This includes 10 in the TWA, 1 PPWC and 1 in CPU. Number of women - 3.
6) IAM - Machinists - Total 6. Includes 5 in Winnipeg and 1 in Hamilton. Number of women - 1 .
