Dear Comrades,

Speaking engagements for SWP and YSA national speakers will now be arranged by "VIEWPOINT: Speakers for Radical Change," a national speakers bureau. VIEWPOINT will soon release a brochure containing biographies and titles of talks, which will be sent to universities and colleges. Quantities of this brochure will also be sent to local areas and to speakers bureaus we cooperate with in local areas.

Speaking engagements for national SWP and YSA speakers have increased greatly in the last few years. In addition to raising money and propagating socialist ideas, speaking engagements for national speakers can and have opened up many opportunities. Appearances can be coordinated with Pathfinder promotion and with press and media work in general. Regional expansion and recruitment opportunities can be maximized by the appearance of national speakers and activity in the various mass movements can be enhanced with national speakers helping to build specific local or national actions. Opportunities for debates, symposiums or panels with opponents or leading figures in various movements can be made possible by the appearance of a national speaker in an area.

Although it is already somewhat late in the school year, it is expected that local areas will still be able to arrange meetings with honoraria for national speakers this spring in cooperation with VIEWPOINT and local speakers bureaus. So that local areas may immediately begin working on engagements, a list of available speakers from VIEWPOINT is enclosed. All information on topics, dates, availabilities and fees should be coordinated with VIEWPOINT which will henceforth be handling all our speaking engagements.

Campus meetings with honoraria can be combined with a forum or educational weekend, thereby offsetting travel fare, in addition to raising extra money and getting a wider hearing for our ideas.

Local speakers bureaus will receive 20 percent on all speaking engagements they arrange for national speakers, after travel and per diem expenses are deducted.
