

NO COLLABORATION WITH THE DEMOCRATS! Take the leadership of the Strike out of the hands of Woodcock and Co.!

STATEMENT OF BARBARA PUTNAM AND FRED VITALE, CANDIDATES OF THE TROTSKYIST ORGANIZATION OF THE US, FOR PRESIDENT AND VICE PRESIDENT

The autoworkers in the United States and Canada have only one force to rely upon in the negotiations and the upcoming strike against the auto companies: that of their own independent organization and power. The Trotskyist Organization of the USA, Section (Sympathizing) of the Fourth International, World Party of Socialist Revolution, believes that the autoworkers in the US and Canada must strike on September 14th, that it must be a strike of all the auto companies, that the autoworkers must use this strike to take the leadership of the strike movement of the US working class to launch an offensive against this decaying system of unemployment,

repression and war. A victorious strike, a strike that will turn back the attacks of the US capitalist class against the workers and oppressed in the US can only be led on the basis of the independent power and organization of the autoworkers them selves. This is above all the lesson that that the autoworkers have learned in the last years since the auto contract in 1973. The last contract with the auto companies was signed by Woodcock and Co. in September 1973. In A MATTER OF MONTHS, in the winter of 1974. the US capitalist class launch ed the largest attack against the US working class since WWII. Massive layoffs, the "energy crisis," inflation and increased police repression was the answer that the US capitalist gave to the the struggle of the workers and oppress ed in this society for a decent living. The auto workers were directly attacked -- at one point over 1/3 of the UAW was on layoff-- today there are still over 200, 000 auto workers unemployed -- unemployed since the last contract. This is the record that the leadership of the UAW-- Woodcock and Co. stands on today-- the record of 200,000 unemployed auto workers, the record of collaboration with the US government and the auto com-panies in their attack on the working panies in their attack on the working class.

This is the same "victory" that Woodcock and Co., along with the Democratic and Republican parties are preparing for the auto workers today. Calling the auto workers "demoralized" and "afraid of another recession"(which they aided), the UAW bureaucrats are leading today a defensive and losing struggle against the "take away" demands of the auto companies. They have nothing to offer against the auto companies, who along with Ford Carter are determined to continue the attack against the working class-unemployment is rising once again, a massive attack is being prepared against the youth in the streets and the auto companies are adding to it with their demands to pay youth the minimum wage and to take away health care benefits, vacation time, while increasing the massive speed-up and repression in the plants. A victorious strike of the auto workers must be led by waging a fight against the entire counterrevolutionary plot of the US ruling class and trade union bureaucrats, throughout society. The independent

power and organization of the auto workers means first of all an offensive against the strikebreaking capitalist state and its Democratic and kepubli-can parties. DOWN WITH THE DEMOCRATS AND REPUBLICANS--EXPELL WOODCOCK FROM THE UAW FOR CLASS COLLABORATION! In return for selling out the auto strike, Woodcock has been promised a place in Carter's Cabinet. Carter has al-ready proposed the institution of wage controls, Carter was a fervent supporter of "right to work" laws while Governor of Georgia. No wonder he is Henry Ford's choice for President as well!

The strike of the auto workers must be a fight against unemployment and inflation -- throughout society. A SLIDING SCALE OF WORKING HOURS AND WAGES -- to divide up all the available work among all those able to work with no loss of pay and with wages to rise in full accordance with the cost of living -- to give everyone in this of living⁻⁻ to give everyone in this society a decent job, to end the brutal speedup and repression in the plants must be the center of the struggle of the auto workers. The SLIDING SCALE OF HOURS AND WAGES has nothing to do with the "gimmicks" proposed by the UAW leadership--"extra vacation time, " "longer weekends," etc. -- but is a fundamental fight against the is a fundamental fight against the entire system - to end unemployment once and for all, to impose workers control over production.

A victorious strike, an offensive against the entire US ruling class cannot be led without ousting this treacherous leadership of the UAW. This is why we call upon all UAW workers, to prepare and lead this strike by organizing a REVOLUTION-ARY WORKERS FACTION OF THE UAW, the faction of the Fourth International, to take the leadership of the strike, to build the independent organization and power of the UAW workers. The UAW workers must organize their own STRIKE COMMI-TTEES, elected in mass meetings of the UAW workers, elected by all the UAW workers, to take the leadership of the strike out of the hands of the bureaucrats, to formulate the demands of the auto workers, to organize MASS PICKETING through organized workers defense guards in order to shut down the BIG THREE on September 14th.

We call upon all auto workers to join with us in making this strike against the bourgeois elections this November. Join the fight of the TO and its candidates for a WORKERS PARTY AND A WORKERS GOVERN-MENT in '76 as the only answer to the attack of the US capitalists. In op-position to the other so-called "workers candidates" in these elections --the US Socialist Workers Party which hides from the auto workers in the plants, saying "they are not yet ready to fight," and the American Commun-ist Party which makes "suggestions" to the UAW bureaucracy and calls upon the auto workers to fight unemployment through legislation in Congress (i.e. the Humphrey-Hawkins Bill) we say that the auto workers in the US are ready to fight -- against the treacherous bureaucracy of Woodcock and Co., against the plots of the Democrate and Republicans and the Democrats and Republicans and the auto companies and against all those in the workers' movement who are trying to hold back this fight. The leaders of the RMC -- Landau, Olson, Shephard and others -- distinguished themselves in the campaign of slander against the organizers of the Trotskyist against the organizers of the Trotskyist and Soviet Defensist Tendencies in the RSL -- Brecht, Myers, and Tracy -- who went on to join the IL/RFI and and found the TO/USA. They've now

At the conclusion of the convention of the US SWP, in the midst of a rapturous monologue about the months ahead for the SWP, in which it would become the strongest and biggest party since the SP of Debs, Peter Camejo denounced the militants of the Trotskyist Organization of the USA distributing FOURTH INTERNATIONAL at the gates as "crazies." He remembered this. And this was all he could say. It is the hour of the world working class. It is the hour of its party.

b) Hargeto Granization of the USA fought to win the militants at the convention of the US SWP to the fight to build a WORKERS PARTY to lead the working class in the fight for a WORKERS GOVERNMENT and a UNITED SOCIALIST REPUBLIC of the TWO AMERICAS; to join the TO/USA in the completion of the rebuilding of the International in the US and throughout the Americas to carry out this task; to subscribe to FOURTH INTERNA-TIONAL and TRUTH, the central weapons with which to wage this fight. In this struggle the TO/USA was supported by the Revolutionary Worker Youth of the USA, Section (Sympathizing) of the RYI, which distributed hundreds of copies of its Call to support the Platform of Combat and Candidates of the Trotskyist Organization in '76, for a COMMON CANDIDATE of the working class on the basis of this Platform.

This political struggle received a very positive response from the militans of the YSA and SWP, especially the young militants from the industrial centers and allied organizations in Latin America, a response in marked contrast with that of the leadership. They read FOURTH INTERNATIONAL and TRUTH₂ compared the Platform of Combat with the "Bill of Rights for Protection." Most often they asked and argued about: Is the working class ready for this fight for a WORKERS PARTY, a WORKERS GOVERNMENT, and a UNITED SOCIAL-IST REPUBLIC of the TWO AMERICAS? Where does THIS Frotskyist Organization and THIS Fourth International come from?

It's a matter of time before these same militants, faced with the increasing acceleration class struggle and the deepening collaboration of the leadership of the SWP with trade union bureaucrats and the Stalinists in capitulating before the bourgeois attack and blocking the workers' mobilization -- already announced with their tacit support to the UMW Executive Board's attack on the striking miners, their full support to Sadlowski's Fight Back Caucus in the USW, and their silence in the face of the new attack in Argentina and the government's announcement of its intention to persecute the SWP under the Voorhis A ct, all in the post-convention issue of the MILITANT -- begin of the working class in the RYI to fight for the Platform of Combat and Candidates of the Trotskyist Organization in '76, will bring it back and be decisive in the struggle they engage against the centrist leadership of the SWP. This will become their response to the attempt of the leadership of the SWP to solve their crisis at the expense of the workers' movement and its militants. to ask and answer the question: What role is the leadership of the SWP playing inreadying the working class for this fight? Where does it come from? In what struggles was the leadership of its "United Secretariat" forged? Who is it grouping around it?

And if to these same militants the struggle led by the TO/USA does not immediately come to mind, its deepening struggle to complete the rebuilding of the International through the mobilization of the young generation anything but slander and physical attacks, and regroup the true proletarian revolutionaries against these methods, the Trotskyist Organization continued its fight to build support for the struggle and results of the work of the INTERNATIONAL WORKERS COMMISSION OF INQUIRY INTO THE SLANDERS AGAINST MICHEL VARGA AND THE FOURTH INTERNATIONAL, to expose the true nature of the allegedly objective commission of inquiry organized by the centrists.

Hundreds of copies of the brochure on the WHITE PAPER of the INTER-NATIONAL WORKERS COMMISSION were distributed. And despite the fact that the organization of this "objective" "commission of inquiry" to whitewash the perpetrators of the slanders and attacks -- the French OCI -- constituted the first step in the attempted centrist regroupment against the rebuilding of the International, many militants said they supported the struggle of the TO/USA against them, and a number were under the impres sion that it was not this "objective" "commission" that the SWP had joined, but the INTERNATIONAL WORKERS COMMISSION against the slanders and attacks. They were quite astonished to find out otherwise.

For its part, the leadership of the SWP deepened its efforts to block the developing political discussion between the TO/USA and the militants of the YSA and SWP, through its now characteristic methods of harassment, force and slander, with the now well-know John Hawkins in the forefront. They organized a band of 35 members of the SWP to prevent the RWY from holding a meeting to discuss the Platform of Combat and the "Bill ot Rights" and win support for the fight for a COMMON CANDIDATE and the TO/USA from holding a meeting in support of the struggle of the INTERNATIONAL WORKERS COMMI-SSION. When the TO/USA re-scheduled its meeting at another location at the close of a session, its militants distributing leaflets -- recounting the previous efforts of

the SWP leadership to block the meeting and advertising the new location and time, were greeted by increasinglyhysterical cries that Michel Varga was a police agent on the part CONTINUED TO FRONT

Free the Political Prisoners in the USSR and Eastern Europe! Against the Repression in Poland!

Mustapha D jemiliev, the Crimean Tartar imprisoned in the USSR is closer to freedom today because of the work and actions organized by the International Workers Committee for the Immediate Liberation of the Political Prisoners of the USSR and Eastern Europe! The Committee decided to make the fight to free Mustapha D jemiliev on an international scale to focus the struggle of the Committee to free all the political prisoners beaten down by Stalinist repression. He has struggled for long years for the return of the Crimean Tartars to Russia who were exiled by Joseph Stalin, and has taken a stand against the occupation of Czechoslovakia by the tanks and military of the USSR. The Committee held a demonstration in Paris in June of workers, militants and organizations of the workers movement at the Russian embassy.

movement at the Russian embassy. Through the BULLETIN OF INFORMA-TION put out by the Committee, the decisive aid of the international working class is brought to bear against Stalinism to force the release of the prisoners. The BULLETIN contains information about the prisoners, articles and reports of the activities of the national committees of the International Committee, and in this way has centralized the struggle, and developed plans on the broadest scale possible for continuing to bring moral and material support to the prisoners. The US Workers Committee is planning demonstrations in Chicago and Detroit, Oct. 2nd and 3rd at the Polish and Russian embassies. Key to the success of the demonstrations is the wide distribution of the BULLETIN among the young workers and militants in the US, to engage the sup-port of the US working class in the fight to free Djemiliev and the Polish workers who built the general strike against the Stalinist regime of Gierek in July.

It is above all the working class of Poland who have shown the world that the workers do not want Stalinism, that they do not believe Stalinism can be reformed. What is at stake in the fight of the Polish workers as well as the struggles of the working class in the USSR, Czechoslovakia, Hungary and the other countries of socialist conquest is the revolutionary unification of the workers in the East and West, which is aimed at the Socialist United States of Europe -- a system of workers governments based on the organized power of the working class.

There is an agreement between the Stalinist bureaucracies and the imperialist powers to prevent information about the events in Poland and Hungary from reaching the ears of the international working class, which can only spur on the fight against Stalinism. It spells the end to the minority rule over the workers as well as an end to capitalism. The International Workers Committee is organizing an accord with the International Workers committee bases the fight to free the political prisoners among factory workers. At Ford River Rouge there were several rallies to Free Mustapha D jemiliev, in Chicago a demonstration at the Polish Embassy, but the work must deepen.

To insure the success of the demonstrations planned for October, the Committee is attempting to engage young workers at Ford River Rouge and Torrence in Chicago in the distribution of the BULLETIN and to engage militants of the YSA and SWP in the actions. Many have expressed true interest and wanted to sign a statement of support to the founding of the US Workers Committee but were prevented by the leadership of the SWP. The US Workers Committee is organizing a planning meeting Sept. 29 to discuss the BULLETIN, and to prepar the posters and defense of the demonstrations of Oct. 2nd and 3rd, at 3310 Junction in Detroit. The Committee proposes to all the organizations and militants of the workers movement to make a joint effort to free the political prisoners through actions developed in the working class.
