London, June 11. Discussing the last French note to Britain on the question of trade with Russia, the "Matin" suggests that the British reply has already been received, and that it "refuses to take account of the French mortgage on Russia." The "Matin" goes on to say: "When it is remembered that the French concessions in Russia represent 700 million francs, the extent of injury that may brithant their protection of life and security of all cinese government. All foreigners residing thus be inflicted on France may be imagined. To this must be added the loss we have already suffered through the transfer to England of the Russian gold which constituted the security for our loans. Therefore, the English commercial operations with Russia are directed against French interest. Thus, one disagreement between England and France has scarcely been effaced, when another one comes up. France passes her time urging to stop enterprises directed by British diplomatists and military authorities against her essential interests."
