

R. I. L. U. PLENUM OPENS WITH U. S. HIGH ON AGENDA

Losovsky Speaks Upon Wall St. Crash

MOSCOW, Dec. 18.—The Sixth Plenum of the Executive Bureau of the Red International of Labor Unions has adopted an agenda as follows:

The results of the economic struggles; the situation in the French revolutionary union federation; the situation in the Trade Union Unity League of the U. S. A.; the situation in the Czecho-Slovakian trade unions; the preparations for the Fifth World Congress of the R.I.L.U.

The speakers at the Plenum will be Losovsky, Merker, Vitkovski, Foster, Zapotocky, Gey and Yussefovitch.

In the opening session, Losovsky, General Secretary of the Red International of Labor Unions (Profintern), declared that the stock exchange crash in the United States affected the whole capitalist world, and would intensify the contradictions of capitalism, making more necessary than ever the independent leadership by revolutionary trade unionists of the wage struggles to come.
