There is real danger that the young men of America will be called upon soon to fight against Mexico. President Coolidge has presented to the Mexican government a note that in every way amounts to an ultimatum.

In Defense of This?

It is accepted as an ultimatum by the Mexican people of every rank, condition and political station, and there is a rullying of these diverse elements such as Mexico has not seen since the revolution.

The American note explicitly states that diplomatic relations with Mexico will be broken if Mexico attempts early in the coming year to apply its alien land and petroleum law-

If Mexico attempts to apply its own laws passed by the representatives of its own people for the purpose of preventing its own resources from passing into the hands of alien exploiters, the United States government will sever diplomatic relations with Mexico.

The severance of diplomatic relations with Mexico under existing conditions will make the war danger between the United States very near and very real.

The American people will recall that a few years ago following the bandit raid on Columbus. New Mexico, an American army invaded Mexico in pursuit of the bandits.

And then, what will they want our young men to fight for?

They will ask you young men to shoulder arms and go down into Mexico to fight a war so sordid, so selfish, so unjust that it would not only enslave the workers of Mexico, but would destroy the last vestige of liberty and democracy in America.

The laws that President Coolidge demands be sotuside do not propose to take any legitimately acquired property from the present alien owners.

They require present alien owners to show that they have proper title, and those showing such title are asked to sign an agreement on January 1, 1927, not to claim the customary protection of their own government for property rights. If they fail to do this they will forfeit their properties to the state.

This is the point at which the United States government is balking, holding that American citizens cannot in any circumstances, waive their right of government protection and contending that the meaning of the new laws is that the Mexican government claims a right to "convert unqualified ownerships into terms of years by the simple device of requiring the existing titles to be exchanged for concession of limited duration."

In its note of July 31 the state department claimed that American property rights acquired in Mexico were "vested rights" which could not be changed.

In other words, Mexico proposes to let all legitimate alien property holders keep the property they have acquired in Mexico, if they wish, as long as they live, BUT IT DEMANDS THAT THEY HOLD THESE PROPERTIES UNDER MEXICAN LAWS AND NOT UNDER FOREIGN GUNS. AMERICAN CAPITALISM DEMANDS NOT ONLY THAT AMERICAN CAPITALISTS BE PER-

MITTED TO HOLD THEIR PROPERTIES IN MEANO ALL THEIR LIVES, BUT THAT THEY HOLD THEM UNDER THE PROTECTION OF AMERICAN GUNS AND THAT THEY HOLD THEM IN PER-PETUITY AS A "VESTED RIGHT" FROM GENER VIION TO GENERATION.

If the Coolidge administration wins, INTERNATIONAL CAPITALISM WITH ITS FNORMOUS AND GROWING INVESTMENTS WILL SOON MAKE IT IMPOSSIBLE FOR THE PEOPLE OF THE VARIOUS COUNTRIES TO RETAIN, OWN, OR RECOVER THE SOIL AND RESOURCES UPON WHICH THEY MUST SUBSIST.

FOREIGN INVESTMENTS WILL STAND THROUGHOUT THE WORLD AS THE ONE FORM OF PROPERTY THAT THE PEOPLE MAY NOT PUBICLY OWN. They may socialize the capital of their own citizens, perhaps, but they will not be permitted by the guns of the imperialists to socialize lands and natural resources acquired by foreign capitalists.

Young men, do you want to shoulder arms, march down into Mexico and fight for this?

Do you want to help destroy the rights of the Moxican people to their own lands and mineral and oil resources?

Do you want to help enslave an aspiring nation that at last sees true democracy and 'liberty?

Do you want to help deprive the Mexican mothers and habes of food and shelter and opportunity? Do you want to help establish a "vested right" throughout the world that would inev tably enslave

humanity? Do you want to make Wall Street supreme on this planet?

Do you want to shed your blood to establish a capitolist and imperialist principle that will enslave you and your children to the end of time?

Do you want to fight to end all liberty and tie up all resources in your own country and deprive your own children of a decent chance in life?

If you do not want to be dragged into such an abominable war, speak, educate, protest, while you can.
