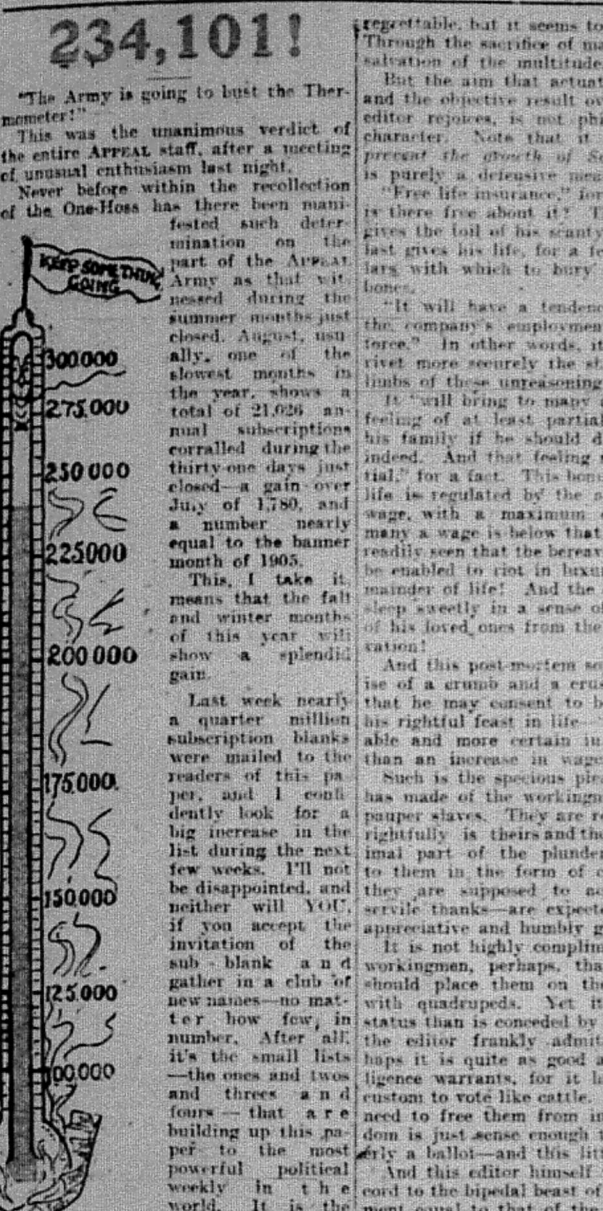

Revolutionary Social Democrats advocate the organization of the working class into a political party to capture the political power and acquire collective ownership of all things collectively used.

Democratic control of industry consists of controlling it instead of permitting the industry and themselves to be controlled by a private owner or a boss under him, as at present.
