"I wish I could take you by the hand and tell you how long I want you to live to continue the work you are so nobly doing."



"CHOLLY" MUST BE SMELLING BAD.

The Rev. Charles Robert Powell, with whom the Editor of this Journal locked horns at Argenta, Ark., on the 15th and 16th of last June in a debate on the subject of Socialism, and who is better known as "Cholley," the "CHURN-HEAD," must be smelling very badly in the nostrils of the Arkansas Baptist, which "Cholley" once edited, but whose editorship he resigned in order to get his claws on a salary of ONE HUNDRED AND FIFTY DOLLARS PER MONTH AND EXPENSES, from the Anti-Saloon League of the State of Arkansas, as the Rev. Ben M. Bogard, who is now acting as Editor of that Journal while "Cholley" "bilks" the Anti-Saloon League, uttered the following editorial on the first page of the Arkansas Baptist in its issue of Oct. 6th, 1909. The editorial follows:

"Dick Maple persists in publishing in his Rip-Saw that Bro. Powell 'Owns and controls' the Arkansas Baptist, and therefore dictates what goes into it. This continued repetition of this falsehood demands a denial on our part. Powell does not own a majority of the Arkansas Baptist stock, and never did. He does NOT DICTATE, OR EVEN SUGGEST, WHAT GOES INTO THE ARKANSAS BAPTIST. He is not even a director of the Company, and has nothing whatever to do with the business or editorial management of the paper. He does not get one cent in salary, or in dividends, or commissions from the Company. Now, what is the use in continuing to publish such a falsehood? If anybody told Maple such stuff, they told a falsehood, and if he was not told such stuff, then he made the lie and told it."
