The Enemy Within is now using his hired Hottentot brains to belabor the masses of the multitude through the movies. The picture shows 25,000 national guardsmen, 5000 genuine hussars, hordes of recruits, thousands of motes, German regiments marching up Broadway, the capture of the capital at Washington, all ending with the triumph of the military and naval forces in the United States over the Enemy Within.

When the Enemy Within put through this colossal lie in the form of a moving picture, he did so with the one solitary idea in view, namely of selling automobiles in the United States. The first part — and in the second part — which is probably the most important — that of massing upon the soil of America an enormous standing army to keep the ever-growing millions happy in the breast of the workers against the owners of the nation in emphysema.

The khaki and the layonet have even been the sign manual of oppression in every land and clime, now and then. Accordingly, reasons the Enemy who lives inside our shores (and who by every principle of justice should have been shot a generation ago for his crimes against America) uses the cry of Preparedness as so plant the armed men within the borders of the nation that for profound reasons has ever scorned them.

The wily Enemy Within seeks to catch the public napping so that his coal mines in the anthracite regions of Pennsylvania may be safe, so that his industrial factories in New England may not be troubled by the hands of a million slaves whom the Enemy has long exploited; so that the steel mills on the Monongahela and at Gary may continue to roll out millions of profits for the Enemy; so that the Foreigner Within; so that the American flag shall still remain at half mast at Denver and that Colorado shall continue to be a Siberian prison for the lives of the women and children brought to the gas chamber that it takes to burn them; that Montana, Idaho and Utah and Arizona shall remain pocket boroughs for the cunning foreigner who takes that make up the Enemy Within.

Yes, the Enemy Within desires National Preparedness so that he can turn the eyes of the people from a state like Texas where an empire larger than Germany is looked up, and a state like Oklahoma where 110,000 families have become renters within the past generation and from Louisiana where a Kirby, a Long and a Bell have produced an economic condition that could only be rivaled by King Leopold's outrages upon the natives of the Congo.

The Enemy Within wishes to perpetuate a system where, according to government statistics, 250,000 men and children are killed each year in the United States, and 4,700,000 are wounded in preventable accidents because our statesmen remain silent in the face of the daily atrocities which are the cause of "peace" by our system of economic and industrial exploitation.

The Enemy Within would blind our eyes to the damning fact pointed out by the greatest soldier-physician-surgeon in the world, and the highest anatomist in the United States army, Sir, Mr. George C. D. G. H. says:

"The preventable mortality from disease in this country is greater than the mortality caused by the European war. Science knows that the chief cause of disease is poverty; that disease can never be eliminated so long as people are forced to live poorly and close together."

The Enemy Within who owns the wealth of the nation and can afford to be satisfied to carry out his designs against American liberty, has a profound contempt for the intelligence of the American people and unless The Rebel makes the mistake of its life they are making a mistake and over in holding such contempt.

In the "Battle Cry of Peace" they show an absurd picture of New York City invaded, Italy Bunkum! Baldernick! New York is already invaded, because the records of the municipal courts of New York show that 101,000 families were smashed in that city within the past year and the first and greatest—the household gods—were pitched with the women and children on the sidewalks by the cold constabulary. The picture is not improved by the sight of 60,000 Marylanders walking by the roadside during the war, and over the Hudson, and practically everyone of those street-walkers was made up by unemployment and by starvation wages that go with the modern monopoly industrial system.

New York invaded! Bah! New York is invaded now and if you doubt it, I point you to Tammany and to the Triangle Fire. Florence where more girls died in a locked-up sweatshop than stories high than did London, and the Paris Commune, and the Russian Revolution, and the Boston women were equalled London. The shooting of Ed. Carrell only worsens the killing of Joe Hill in Utah.

The indemnity paid by the Government of Brussels is as more than the Phillips Dodge Copper Company has demanded of the miners when that Company sought to destroy their unions, increase their hours and reduce their wages at Morenci and Clifton, Ariz. Last month.

In the light of these facts why should we worry about the German invasion? Suppose the Germans should invade Chicago and execute J. Ogden Armour as an enemy of society who caused the death of more than 10,000 men by the building of the "enhanced" beef to our soldiers while our nation was at war with Spain. Then suppose that the Germans set up their municipally-owned slaughter and crematorium and slaughter for working families, that a hundred thousand babies would be alive two years from now—that are now sentenced to death by the profit-mongering Enemy Within in Chicago.

Why should we worry if the Germans invaded St. Louis, razed the tenements and made beer ovens as in Deutschland instead of the poisonous stuff that is now handed out by our native entrepreneurs?

Why should we worry if Von Hindenburg should stretch the necks of the schemes of the Enemy who has poisoned or "enhanced" that city with the aid and assistance of the Republicans for money and price received from hypocritical Rockefeller and apoplexy Morgan?

Why should we worry if after grabbing St. Louis Von Hindenburg turns over to General Mackensen the simple task of "conquering" Arizona, Oklahoma, Texas, Louisiana and the Delta of the Mississippi? Livers there a man within these states who has the brass and effrontery to say that conditions would be any worse than they are at the moment in which we write? After a hundred years the Democrats' politicians have not been able to fight the Mississippi. How can they fight Mackensen? Mackensen would dam and level and flood every watercourse along the route of his march as his conscripts have done in Northern Germany and across the Zuyder Zee in Holland. It is well within the bounds of possibility that he could save Arkansas City, Pine Bluff and other places that the countless thousands have not been able to protect after one hundred years experience with the annual devastation of the "Big Muddy."

Why should we worry if Mackensen should send an army corps to Oklahoma City and, after killing the prohibitionist assembly general, should increase 600 bootleggers and make that town dry for the first time in its history, while waiting for export brewers to manufacture the legitimate extract of malt?

Why should we worry if he joins forces with the Oklahoma gangster in Dallas and gains Colonel Shafter with his Hilde, the mayor with his crooked real estate deal, Colling Thomas with his 300 crooked lawyers and the representatives of the state's national insurance companies who charge premiums five times larger for the same amount than they charge in Louisiana?

Why should we worry if General Mackensen should decide that it is easier to move his 42-inch howitzers and all his other heavier artillery down the middle of the bed of the Trinity than along the rotten roads that lead to his next objective point—Austin, the state capital?

Why should we worry if, upon his arrival, he should make the prisoner of James E. Ferguson and court-martial him for charging 90 per cent. in his private business as a Temple banker, and then refuse to roll out millions of profits for the Enemy; so that the Foreigner Within; so that the American flag shall still remain at half mast at Denver and that Colorado shall continue to be a Siberian prison for the lives of the women and children brought to the gas chamber that it takes to burn them; that Montana, Idaho and Utah and Arizona shall remain pocket boroughs for the cunning foreigner who takes that make up the Enemy Within.
