How About Markets?

"The question is often asked: 'How under Socialism will you handle the marketing of such staple farm products as cotton, wheat, rice etc?'"

The best way to avoid doubting Thomas is to show them the many things actually doing along this line of line.

One of the best illustrations is in Australia. In 1915 the wheat speculators and flour men were taking advantage of the war situation by robbing the producers on one side and the consumers on the other in the good old fashion. We now know well and well.

There is a large delegation of Socialists in the Australian parliament. Assisted by labor members they took hold of this crisis in the through-going way that only working class representatives can be depended on to take.

They wanted no time splitting conditional hands nor did they rest in piecemeal concessions or any other class of workers.

At the same time the people were given all the trustful industries giving service or selling goods to the producers on the one side and the consumers on the other. They just cut the Gordian knot and passed a sweeping program about like the following:

"Hereafter all wheat grown in Australia will be handled by the government marketing commission."

The farmers brought all their wheat to the government warehouses and elevators, where they received an advance of 70 cents a bushel.

This money was advanced without one cent of interest.

Then the government stored the wheat at a cost to the farmer of only ONE-TWENTIETH of a bushel and every farmer whether his wheat was marketed first or last—received a total of \$1.40 per bushel at the very time when the American farmer was receiving not in excess of \$1.08 per bushel.

An interesting side of the situation was that the wheat and flour trust sought to put the farmer to the test.

Their first move was to run the price of flour out of sight so as to make the farmer feel the profit and cause discontent against the government's program.

The Australian parliament came back like a thousand of brick by nationalizing the flour factories and producing flour at cost.

The next move of the trust was to tie up all ships that were needed to send out people's wheat.

The parliament broke this conspiracy with one blow. It authorized enough ship tonnage to haul the wheat at cost.

The people already had the railroads so the flour trust intended to whip the speculators were routed, and live-and-let-live prices were established to both consumer and producer.

With reference to the cotton question for instance, the cotton of the foregoing is plain as light.

Secretary Houston of the U. S. Department of Agriculture in a recent interview made the statement that the farmer receives only 35 per cent of the value of what his product ultimately sells at.

If the cotton farmers of the South had a little more backbone than a jelly-fish and would use their heads for something besides inventing their own new sky-places, here is what they could do:

Quit voting the Democratic or Republican party ticket, that stand, and have always stood with the cotton ginner and elevator men, and vote for the only party that is of, by, for the wageworker and wage-earning farmer—the Socialist party.

That paid the name people the cotton trust, stock and barrel, including a congress, oil mills, docks, warehouses, and all other means connected with the handling of that cotton—precisely as the Australian people now completely control the wheat trust.

Only the Socialist Congress would provide that the cotton farmer receive the full value of his product. Houston says he is receiving only a third of what he is actually worth at—this not counting the twenty or more prices tacked on to cotton goods.

So under a government of, by and for the producers, the cotton farmer would be receiving say, \$80 per bale would receive three times that, namely, \$240 a bale.
