They just breeze right in and clean the place up and club hell out of anyone who is audacious enough to refuse to go. Then when the workers are thrown out into the street the real fun commences.

On several occasions the guardians of the peace have simply outdone themselves. Seventy-five of the thugs headed by a bun named Griffin—armed with rifles and shot guns—went parading, as nearly as possible, down East Nineteenth Street.
